The French Ski Federation and the Organizing Committee of the AUDI FIS SKI CROSS CUP in Val Thorens are pleased to invite all Freestyle Nations to attend this event from December 19th to 20th, 2020.

For your information, there is no reserve day.

1 / Program

You will find enclosed the provisional program of the event according to the FIS calendar. The OC reserves the right to modify this schedule, depending on the snow conditions or / and the decision of the competition jury.

Please note that the TCM will take place in the Meeting room of the “Maison de Val Thorens” on the 1st floor under the Club des Sports reception.

2 / Arrival

The appointment for the welcome, information and accommodation will be at the Sport’s Club Office at the « Maison de Val Thorens » on Thursday 17th December 2020 between 02.00 and 06.00 pm.

Outside these hours, for all different questions regarding the organisation, please ask directly at the Club des Sports reception : Opening hours : 09.00 – 12.00 am & 02.00 – 05.00 pm

Each competitor and official will receive a 3 days SX stadium skipass and a wristban. This wristband must be worn all the time and showed if required.

3 / Accommodation

Teams will be accommodated in several hotels or residences *** and more on half-board basis from Thursday afternoon the 17th of December to Sunday 20th December afternoon (3 nights).

Because of the sanitary situation, it won't be possible to have the lunch on the competition's days (18/19/20th December) on the SXWC' site as usual.

All teams are going to take the lunch on their own hotel after the competition.

The OC takes in charge lunch of December 18/19/20th.

Each team will pay the total of the accommodation expenses at their arrival at the OC and a fully refundable breakage deposit will be required directly by the hotel or residence (major credit card only).

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, mini bar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes directly at the hotel.

The official single room FIS' quota is 2 single rooms per team and 1 additional single room can be purchased at the rate of CHF100.

The OC will book maximum 3 single rooms per team, no more.

Please, fill in your accommodation needs on the FIS Online Entry System (Team size) with a provisional completed rooming list with any requirements about rooms & place sharing before **November 13th, 2020**.

4/ ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

The final entries of your competition team (competitors, officials, and other staff) with your arrival and departure dates (Names, FIS code for the participants and Gender) must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than **December 9rd, 2020**.

For any changes notified after this deadline, the organizing committee may invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Ski Association concerned. Teams or persons who register late have no right to reservation at the FIS rate.

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Ski Cross points in one of the valid FIS points list.

The minimum FIS point requirements per FIS Freestyle Ski Cross World Cup event are :

Standards / Requirements	Ski Cross FIS Points
Freestyle FIS Points	100
Alpine FIS points list rank in any event	Top 50

5/ BIBS

All competitors must wear their bibs during the official training, competition and awards ceremony after the competition.

6/ PRIZE MONEY & PRIZE MONEY TAXES

Please note that the prize money will be transferred to the athletes' account. A bank transfer form for prize money will be provided at the first TCM .

It's in the duty of each athlete to fill out and return the respective document no later than 24h after the race to the organizer.

A withholding French tax (15%) will be retained on the prize money.
