### **4. BIBS**

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. Bibs will be given after the full entry fee payment and the time will be announced in the team captain meeting. Fee for lost/not returned bib is 30 €.

### **5. ENTRY FEE MOGULS EC**

Entry fee: CHF 80 per athlete (74 Euros) per competition incl. lift ticket for the venue lift in the Mogul Valley. Training days: 20 CHF (18 Euros) per athlete incl. lift ticket for the venue lift.

Payments by Euros only, preferably by teams, by bank transfer by February 12 to Jyväskylän Freestyle Seura ry Nordea Bank Finland BIC: NDEAFIHH IBAN FI43 1045 3000 1956 68 Or in the venue by credit card. Because of Covid-19, no cash is accepted.

### **6. PRIZE MONEY**

Prize money will be awarded according to the FIS rule.

### **7. ACCIDENT INSURANCE**

Each competitor must carry his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, City of Jyväskylä, Laajavuori Ski Resort, FIS, Ski Sport Finland nor Jyväskylä Freestyle Club assume no responsibility for accidents, damage or loss of equipment, and second and third party claims during the event.

## COVID-19

To ensure the health and safety for everyone, the OC is working in accordance with the National Health regulations as well as with FIS, in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines. OC has received special permission for the teams to enter Finland. All teams must submit full list of team personnel (name, birthdate, task on the team and from where you will enter Finland). OC will send that information for the Finnish border control. NOTE: Border control will not allow any persons enter Finland which are not on the list! List has to be sent no later than 28.1.2021.

To receive competition accreditation, a negative Covid-19 test no older than 72 hours is required before entering Finland. There will be also Covid-19 test for all the teams in Taivalkoski on Tuesday 2.2. Teams has to pay their own test expenses. Price is 179 €/person. Tests has to be paid in race office at the time of registration. There will be more information about the tests and necessary precautions due to the pandemic available about two weeks before the competition.

All competitors must have their own medical insurance (ICR art 212) which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment expenses.
