## 2. Rules

- Georgian Ski Federation , Mountain Resorts Development Company and the organizing committee of the AUDI FIS SKI CROSS WORLD CUP are organizing Ski Cross World Cup on February 26<sup>th</sup>· 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>; in Bakuriani ski resort, “Didveli” Mountain.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations of Freestyle Skiing.
- This competition is a Ski Cross event and is open to both Men, Women and Mixed Teams Event.
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserves right to change the schedule depending on the snow conditions, weather or decision of the competition jury.

## 3. Entries

### **Registration/Entries**

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page: <http://www.fis-ski.com/> "Member Section". FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. ### ***Deadlines for Team Entries:***

*Preliminary Entries (women/men): 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2021*

*Final Entries: 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2021*

Competitors entered into FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Ski Cross points in one of the valid FIS points list. The minimum FIS point requirements per FIS Ski Cross World Cup event are:

#### 4. Registration and means of Payment

- All teams are responsible to arrive and register at race office – located in Hotel “Crystal ” on the first Team Captain’s meeting, February 23<sup>rd</sup>.
- Accommodation with Half Board for the dates: 23-28 February 2021, is CHF 60 per person per night.

“No Shows” will be charged to the National Associations by LLC “TRIFECTA.”

**Important information: To accommodate all athletes, coaches and officials in a correct way, we do need your updated Preliminary Team Entries as soon as possible, January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021, the latest.**

**After the above mentioned Deadline for Team Entries the FIS rate for hotel accommodation can’t be guaranteed anymore.**
