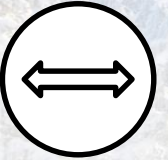
# BASIC PRINCIPLES



## PROTECTION

–

wearing a mask and washing hands for 30 sec.



## DISTANCING

–

always maintain 1,5 m physical distance



## HYGIENE

–

do not interact with the general public (autographs and selfies are strictly forbidden)

# BASIC PRINCIPLES



## **CONFINEMENT** –

stay within one's sensitive bubble and avoid all unplanned or unsafe outside contact



## **COMMUNICATION** –

inform the doctors and organising committee in case of any symptoms. Identify any contacts at risk



## **VENTILATION** –

ventilate any and especially all enclosed spaces

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

## FIS PASSPORT - ATHLETES



- completion the health questionnaire in the FIS Passport every day of the event
- completion of the Pre-Arrival Questionnaire
- constant updating of the whereabouts
- overview over all Corona test results
- an athlete will be accepted for accreditation if a negative PCR test is available

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

## ANTIGEN RAPID TESTS - ATHLETES

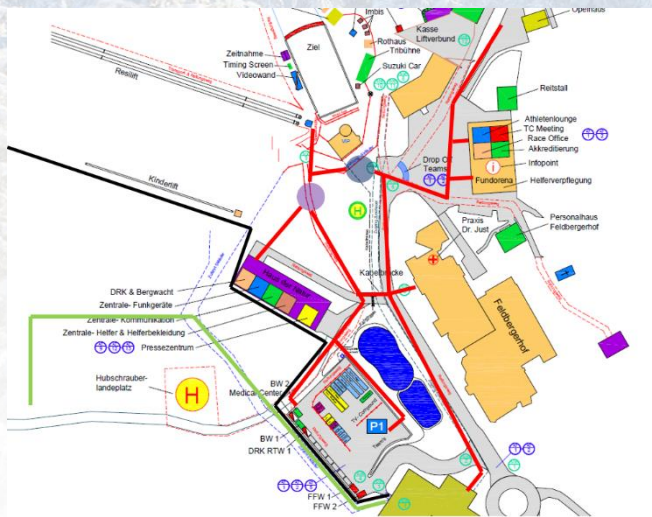





- mandatory performance of a Corona Antigen rapid test on Thursday 28/01/2021
  - the time slots for the teams will be announced later
  - the antigen rapid tests costs 20 € per person and will be paid by the teams
  - the test center is located on the left side of “Feldbergerhof”

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

## WALKING ROUTES

- there will be no public ski operation
- demarcation of the event area from day guests



-  worldcup
-  pedestrian / toboggan operation
-  barrier



# SAFETY MEASURES FOR ENTERING THE EVENT



- fever measurement
- completion the health questionnaire in the FIS Passport
- a daily corona rapid test is NOT necessary
- color marking on the accreditation when the gate has been passed through
  - if the accreditation is not yet available, a ribbon will be issued and later replaced

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## ACCOMMODATIONS TEAMS



- separate teams from other hotel guests if possible – use stairs instead of elevators, try to accommodate the teams on the same floor
- maintain appropriate distance between twin beds
- if possible, provide a separate entrance for the team
- do not clean rooms when team members are present - avoid all contact with housekeeping personnel
- if necessary provide isolation rooms

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## ACCOMMODATIONS TEAMS



- make sure that the required space between other guests and the teams's dining rooms is guaranteed
- prepare the dining room / dining areas before the teams arrive
- enough water / beverages already on each table
- avoid buffet-style meals

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## ACCREDITATION AREAS

- only one person per team (ex. Team captain or head coach) is allowed to pick up the accreditations at the Race office (Fundorena)
- one-way street principle in narrow areas

## SKILIFT RESI

- there will be no regular ski operation
- the Resilift II and the 2-seater chairlift will be available for the World Cup
- wearing a mask is compulsory when taking the lift

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## RACE OFFICE / TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING



- the race office will be in the Fundorena
- access only for black and the Teams bubble
- access / exit control by Barcode scanning
- Team Captain Meeting will be held online or on site with a limited number of people and appropriate distance

# HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

## WINNER PHOTOS / OFFICIAL AWARD CEREMONIE



- award ceremonies in the finish area after the races
- physical distance of 1,5 m between athletes and journalists during the podium photo
- no handshaking when the trophies are awarded
- athletes must remain on the podium
- no public award ceremony

## MEASURES IF A PERSON WAS RECENTLY DIAGNOSTED WITH COVID-19

Athletes may participate if

- they have been tested positive 3 months to 2 weeks before arrival
- they have completed quarantine
- they have been free of any symptoms for at least three days
