On behalf of the German Ski Association, the Hochschwarzwald Tourismus GmbH and the Organizing Committee cordially invites your nation, as a member of Fédération Internationale de Ski (FIS), to participate in the AUDI FIS Ski Cross World Cup Feldberg from 29th to 31st of January 2021.

Enclosed, you'll find some information concerning the event, your stay in the Black Forest Highlands, the area, how to reach us and who to contact in case of questions.

We kindly remind you to announce the provisional team entries by December 20th 2020 and do confirm the final entries by January 19th 2021.

We're looking forward to meeting you here in the Black Forest Highlands.

COVID-19 SITUATION

In order to ensure the health and safety for the athletes and team personnel, the LOC is working in accordance with the Regional and National Health regulations as well as with FIS in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines together with the World Health Organisation (WHO) information and recommendations. The LOC and FIS Event Task Force has been established and is monitoring all developments. The corresponding arrangements are currently being put together in a separate document. This will be published and communicated by the LOC at a later stage. All competitors must have their own medical insurance (ICR art 212) which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment expenses. Updated COVID-19 relevant medical procedures that may be required will be communicated whenever relevant.

REGISTRATION – ENTRIES:

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page within the mentioned deadlines: www.fis-ski.com/ "Member Section". FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. Entries by mail or fax are no longer accepted.

FIS LICENSE

All athletes are required to have a valid FIS license.

COMPETITION RULES:

This competition, for both men and women, will be held under the FIS Cross World Cup rules. All national associations affiliated to FIS are invited to compete.

According to the FIS international calendar, the competition will take place on January 29th and 31st 2021 following the official program.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Please note that accommodations will be available at the FIS rate for the dates of the program only.

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS rate. The hotel rates for early arrival or late departure are available upon request.

Teams will be lodged in hotel with half board, from Monday night January 25th to Monday morning February 01st 2021 (6 nights at the FIS rate, 60 CHF).

Each coach has to pay his team accommodation expenses directly at the hotels front desk the day of his arrival (Monday January 25th). No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. If they do a reservation the hotel is free to apply the normal hotel prizes.

Teams must forward their team accommodation requests using the FIS Online Entry System (ladies/men/officials) until 29.12.2020.

According to the FIS Rules the rates are CHF 60.00/day per team member (athletes and team officials) for accommodation and half board and has to be paid directly at the hotel.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves. "No Shows" become charged to the National Associations directly at the Hotel.

Important information:

In order to accommodate all competitors, coaches and officials in a correct way, we do need your provisional entries 20.12.2020, the latest. After the above mentioned deadline for team entries the FIS rate for hotel accommodation can't be guaranteed anymore.

TEAM CAPTAINS MEETINGS / RIDERS LOUNGE

The Team Captains meeting and the athlete lounge will be in the "Fundorena" (ground floor), Dr.-Pilet-Spur 11, 79868 Feldberg (same place as the Race Office).

Please see schedule for meeting times. Team Captains meetings might be online due to the Covid-19 crisis. The organizing committee will provide more detailed information later.

ACCREDITATION

All officials and competitors will receive an accreditation card from the Organizing Committee providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn all the time.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping control testing maybe conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

PRESS CENTER

The Press Centre will be located at the Haus der Natur (first floor), Dr.-Pilet-Spur 4, 79868 Feldberg (Schwarzwald).

CEREMONIES, PUBLIC BIB DRAW/HEAT PRESENTATION:

Due to the Covid-19 crisis there will be no public heat presentation.

The prize giving will be right after the race in the finish area, Feldberg.

The competitors **MUST** wear bibs during the official training, competition and prize giving ceremony!
