



Information COVID-19 Testing

Here comes information regarding how the LOC will work with testing during the AUDI FIS Ski Cross World Cup 20-24th of January 2021.

Tests:

The tests we will use is Panbio COVID- 19 Ag Rapid Test, an antigen test. The test will give results in 15- 20 minutes.

The tests will be taken with assistance from medical personnel.

General information:

To follow the FIS prevention guidelines the LOC together with local healthcare have decided that everyone in the teams need to have a negative PCR test upon arrival.

If you have done a PCR test inside 72 hours of your arrival date you do not need to do additional testing at Idre Fjäll! This of course need to be in your FIS passport.

If not, you will need to get tested at the resort according to the schedule that will be sent out.

All team members have responsibility to fill out their FIS passport! If they have not we will not give out bib or accreditation. **Whereabouts, questionnaire and latest test all need to be filled out!**

Where the testing will take place:

The testing will take place in the conference room Nipsalen. This year you will have your own entrance so please do not go through the big reception, instead use the door opposite the activity center - there will be signs.

To limit the amount of people in the room at the same time the LOC will provide a time schedule where we will provide each team a specific time when they will be able to go to the testing.



We will communicate the test result via email. Therefore we ask all teams to please send a list with all team members and their email addresses to amelia.westblad@idrefjall.se

Costs:

The costs for the testing will be 400 SEK (39.1696 EUR). The testing can be added to your invoice or you can pay at the testing center. If you like to add it to your invoice contact Amelia Westblad.

If testing positive:

If someone test positive all in the same household will be isolated.

Due to Swedish regulations the others member of that household will not be able to compete even if negative – all in the household will be isolated and put in quarantine.

The Swedish regulations are that you need to be in quarantine seven days, and two of those days without symptoms.

If you have been COVID-19 Positive

If you have been positive with COVID-19 and have antibodies this need to be filed out in you FIS passport – you are still of course welcome to the compete/the competitions if you have proof of said antibodies.

If you have proof of antibodies inside 60 days from first competition you will not need to do the testing at the resort.

Testing before departure

Idre Fjäll are not able to do any PCR tests before departure. However, there is possibilities at Arlanda airport that you can look in to.
