3. ACCOMMODATION and TRANSPORTATION


Accommodation is provided at hotel Edelweiss, located in Sil village, 15 minutes from the resort. Costs are as follows:

Double room (half board + transfer to the hill) 55 Eur per person per day paid in cash.

Closest airport is Lviv (LWO) with 4 hours travel. The cost of one-way trip makes 140 EUR per minivan (up to 8 persons) and 100 EUR per car.

4. RACE OFFICE

Race office will be located in the Alpen House Hotel (by the competition site, at top of the lower chairlift). Contacts of the race secretary (secretary@sfu.org.ua +380503342701 – Viber, WhatsUp). TCM will be held in the Race Office or online.

Registration is held in the race office before first TCM.

5. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are 50 CHF (per person per competition day). Entry fees are to be paid at the Race Office (cash) by first TCM.

6. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. 20 USD (or 15 EUR) deposit per bib will be charged at the registration TCM.

7. LIABILITY \ ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Ski Associations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on courses during competition or training, the medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision to local hospital in co-operation with the respective team's medical personnel.

12. OTHER INFORMATION

Covid-19 procedures and restrictions:

General information for entry is provided at the governmental resource https://visitukraine.today/. By January 9th, the entry is allowed with no self-isolation with negative PCR test not older than 48-hours and mandatory possession of medical insurance, covering expenses in case of Covid. There may be requirement to pass express test on cite before competition, which costs about 40 Eur depending on the laboratory. As long as the list of the countries and procedures are regularly updated we suggest to work on the arising questions in regular flow of work.
