### COVID 19

**Important :** Due to the Covid-19 requirements, we have adapted the registration procedure and the organisation of the TC meeting for this season. ☒ All participants (athletes and staff) have to provide a negative RT-PCR 0 naso-pharyngeal test, performed no later than 72h prior to the declared arrival on site by the team captain or racers OR an « Abbott or Roche » serology test ( antibody ) >0 less than 8 weeks.

**Attention : due to new French Covid regulation, all people coming in France, need to have a negative PCR test less than 72h to pass the Border.**

☒ All teams MUST provide prior to the event the Contact Sheet (Annexe 1) with all data of competitors and staff. You can file the PDF or the XLS file as you prefer.

## 2. Rules

- The French freestyle Association and les Arcs Committee are organising an international Europa Cup Freestyle competition, part of the 2021 FIS Freestyle Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for freestyle skiing.
- This competition is a **Big Air Event** for both men and women
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury

Due to the Covid 19 requirements we only accept online payments for entry fees and tickets. Tickets for Coaches and Team Staff are free according the contingent in CoC Rule EC1.3.

Coaches & support staff must all be registered by email.

Anyone who is not registered correctly will not receive a coach ticket or access to the competition site.

All coaches & athletes tickets must be collected from the race office.

A FIS license valid is mandatory.

## 5. TC Meeting

The Team Captain Meeting is obligatory for all nations and teams.

## 6. Bibs and Helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10 € per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

## **7. Liability**

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, les Arcs , the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

## **8. Accident Insurance**

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, les Arcs, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

## **9. Accident Protocol**

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.
