4. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are 25 EUR per person per competition day. Entry fees must be paid at Race office at arrival day. Ski pass for lift №8 is free for competition / training days.

5. RACE OFFICE

TCM will be held either in Race Office according to the program schedule.

6. TRANSPORTATION

Closest airports are: Lviv (LWO) with 5 hours travel and Ivano-Frankivsk airport (IFO) with 2 hours. The cost of one-way trip makes 3400 UAH (approximately 100 EUR per minivan – up to 8 persons). 7. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. 10 EUR deposit per bib will be charged at the first TCM.

8. HELMETS

Please, note, that according to the Bukovel Ski Resort safety policy, all those on skis **MUST** wear helmets (otherwise they won't be allowed to go to the chairlift for skiers). Going up without skis (or on the chairlift for pedestrians) helmet is not obligatory.

9. LIABILITY \ ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members of the National Ski Associations who will attend and participate in the competitions shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competitions.

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance.

10. COVID REGULATIONS

To enter Ukraine from RED ZONE countries, every person must:

1. Provide a negative PCR test (paper version with stamp) done no more than 48 hours before the border crossing. In this case self-isolation is not necessary
2. Have an insurance policy issued by a Ukrainian insurance company or a foreign insurance company that has a representative office in Ukraine. This can be also done via <https://visitukraine.today/>.

Upon request there is a possibility to make a PCR test on 20.02.21 with transfer to Ivano-Frankivsk.
