Nordkette Skyline Park – Innsbruck, Tirol, Austria, 22. – 24. February 2021

Innsbruck, Austria, is proud to host the third edition of the Freeski World Rookie Fest from February 22nd – 24th, 2021. Once again Nordkette Skyline Park will host the next generation of Freeski to showcase the future of the sport. Riders will hit the Slopestyle course above Innsbruck to determine who will get tickets for this year's World Rookie Tour finals later on this season. This year's Slopestyle event is held as a FIS-Race.

Due to Covid-19 Restrictions in Austria only Riders born from 2007 with active FIS-License are allowed to participate. For sure we will go back to our normal age categories as soon as the situation allows. As it is the only possibility to do the event, it will be held as a FIS-Race-which means as well adult riders are welcome.

ENTRY CRITERIA TO THE NORDKETTE SKYLINE PARK FREESKI WORLD ROOKIE FEST Slopestyle (who can join)

- Riders, male and female, born 1st January 2003 till 2007 are admitted into the rookie fest.
- Riders will be divided in two age groups: born 2003 until 2005 (Rookies) 2006 and 2007 (Groms).

- As this year the event will be held as a FIS Race - FIS License is necessary. Athletes licensed starting with 2007 and older are allowed to enter the event.

Registration and entries:

Entries will be accepted without nations quotas and via the official FIS Team entry form by National Ski Associations. Entries has to be sent not later than 18.02.2021.

Covid-19 Precisions

Dear team captains. Please read through the following rules very carefully. These regulations are established by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Health, Austrian Ski Federation and the LOC in cooperation with FIS. It is your responsibility to inform your entire team and make sure all members follow these rules without exceptions.

- **1.** What is important:
 - Take personal responsibility very serious
 - hygiene measures at all times (regular hand washing, regular disinfection)
 - maintain a minimum distance of 2 meter in all areas (social distancing)
 - wear FFP2 Masks at all times
 - o on the entire event site, except
 - during the practice of sport
 - in the start area right before the start
 - o inside all buildings
 - o for all transports in buses, shuttles, gondolas, chair lifts
 - o in the common areas of your accommodation
- 2. COVID-19 tests:
 - Everybody (athletes, coaches and staff) who wants to get an accreditation for the event needs to present a negative COVID–19 test result (PCR or Antigen not older than 72 hours before the start of training). The negative test result must be presented when collecting the accreditations.
 - Accreditation for persons with a previously diagnosed COVID-19 infection
 - present the PCR COVID-19 positive test result made between 2 weeks and 3 months before the arrival

- o free of COVID-19 symptoms for a minimum of 3 days before arrival
- 3. Daily Health Questionnaire for athletes, coaches and LOC: https://forms.gle/9KkUebTUAtDt3381A
 - has do be filled out and sent online mandatory every morning before showing up at the bottom station of the gondola (will be controlled) Starting with the first day of training.
- 4. Team Captains Meeting (TCM): Online via Zoom Meeting. Link will be provided through the Whatsapp Group
- 5. Transportation rules for cars/team busses:
 - max two people can be carried in each row of seats
 - wearing FFP2 mask is mandatory
- 6. Rules for Hotel/Accomodation:
 - professional athletes and coaches are allowed to stay in hotels, closed for the public
 - FFP2 mask mandatory, except at the table while meals
- 7. Transportation rules for gondola/chairlift:
 - checkpoint bottom station for the correct questionnaire by the COVID-19 Manager
 - FFP2 masks mandatory for gondola, possibility to get one at the bottom station
 - FFP2 mask for chairlift
 - half capacity at all times
 - staggered, team by team







- 8. Avoid crowds: inspection, toilets, gondola, chairlift
 - spend your free time only with members of your team in small groups
- 9. COVID-19 Communication
 - in case of COVID-19 symptoms immediately inform the COVID-19 Manager who is responsible for the Event – Roman Kuss – <u>roman.kuss@oesv.at</u> / +43 664 1449856
 - COVID-19 Manager activates the necessary COVID-19 measures all communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with LOC and FIS

NEW entry requirements for Austria

Dear all,

due to Covid-19 pandemic, new measures to contain the Covid-19 virus have been tightened. The regulation in force since **Friday**, **15.01.2021** and adapted on **Friday 12.02.2021** means that entry into Austria is from that on only possible under the following conditions:

2. Competing in FIS-Races / National Events and Training issues:

- FIS-races, national events and training issues are not from national interest and no special exceptions can be done. Furthermore only professional athletes can enter Austria without quarantine by following regulations:
 - Online pre travel registration through <u>https://entry.ptc.gv.at/en.html</u> and select exception "The Entry is subject to an exception in § 4 (3) or § 5 (5) of the Covid-19 entry regulation and enter all the data required. You will get a confirmation via Email or QR Code.
 - <u>Medical certificate or test result</u> (Antigen or PCR) which confirms that you are negative tested on Covid-19 (not older than 72 hours) and the test result must include all datas named on point 1.
 - Letter of confirmation from your NSA that you are a professional athlete / coach / staff
- If you can not provide the mentioned documents or if you are not a professional athlete, a 10 days quarantine is mandatory for entering Austria.

3. Travel restrictions from and to Tyrol (temporary valid for 10 days till 21.02.2021, extension TBD)

- Since Friday, 12.02.2021 <u>all persons (!!) leaving the territory / region of Tyrol</u> (North-Tirol) (no matter outside or inside Austria) have to present a negative Antigen or PCR test not older than 48 hours (in German our English) at the boarder.
- > This restrictions are not valid for East-Tyrol (Osttirol).
- > Transit traffic through Tyrol is not included from this restriction.
- Entering Tyrol from abroad mentioned above Point 1 measures count. When entering Tyrol from an other part from Austria, there are currently no restrictions.
