For all athletes, coaches and staff we offer to handle the transport of the luggage between the destinations. Please see more detailed specific Covid-19 information for luggage handling.

### 7. Payment

<u>Travel Expenses</u> will be transferred to each Team's bank account in Holmenkollen in the Raw Air Secretariat in the Scandic Holmenkollen Park. Please note that it will not be possible to receive cash.

<u>Prize Money</u> will be paid by bank transfer to the Athletes after the FIS World Cup RAW AIR Tournament.

In addition to the prize money regulated by the FIS WC rules there will be paid extra prize money to the FIS World Cup RAW AIR Tournament overall top 3 athletes.

### 8. Income tax information for prize money

- The current Norwegian tax rate for non resident athletes is 15%.
   Due to a special tax convention between Norway and USA, income tax will not be deducted by the OC for income less than USD10000 "the income shall be taxable only in the State of which the sportsman is a resident".
- Tax will be deducted by the OC according to the Norwegian Foreign Artist Taxation Act, and taxes will be paid by the OC according to the regular tax legislation in Norway.

### 9. Waxing facilities - location

Holmenkollen: close to the ski jumping hill – behind the lift lobby

Lillehammer: close to the outrun in the ski jumping hill

Trondheim: Ski wax cabins will be located at the team area at the hill. Vikersund: Ski wax cabins will be located at the team area at the hill.

There will be no ski-waxing rooms available at the hotels.

### 10. Regulations of radio equipment

The import, export and the operation of radio equipment in Norway is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radiotransmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications. The application must be forwarded before 1 February.

### 11. Visa Regulations

## Important information regarding Covid-19-protocol

### **Arrival**

All teams, officials, suppliers and others are obligated to arrive in Norway at latest 3 days before the first official training:

Latest arrival in Oslo for SJ Men will be Tuesday 09.03.

Latest arrival in Oslo for SJ Ladies will be Wednesday 10.03.

All teams and officials have to use the OCs shuttle service from Oslo Airport Gardermoen to the arrival test and hotel in Oslo. Detailed information regarding flights, number of persons etc. must be reported to the OC through the FIS online system according to the deadlines in the invitation.

Cars arriving from abroad are obligated to drive directly to Oslo with no stops inside Norway except when it's absolutely necessary, ex for refuelling.

All persons entering Norway are obligated to register their entry through:

All team members and officials have to update all necessary information in the FIS covid-19-passport according to FIS rules.

### Test protocol

Persons arriving to Norway are required to present a SARS-CoV-2- test (PcR or Antigen) taken 24 hours prior to departure from the foreign destination.

All persons will be tested (PcR-test) on arrival in Oslo, and have to stay in their respective hotel room until the test result is known to be negative. After negative result of this test, everyone must undergo a "sports quarantine" for first 3 days.

New tests (Antigen) will be taken after 3, 6 and 9 days. A detailed plan and time schedule for testing will follow. Additional tests before departure will be offered.

All tests in Norway will be done by the NSF/LOC supplier Volvat Medical Center.

### Sports quarantine

From the negative test result from the arrival test to the first official training, all athletes and other personnel arriving from abroad has to undergo a "sports guarantine". This means:

- Athletes can do individual training outside without contact with others
- Training in the jumping hill can be done with a limited number of athletes at the venue at the same time. Training times will be assigned from the OC
- Indoor training is currently under discussion with the Norwegian Health Authorities. Information will be forwarded as soon as possible.
- Transportation to training has to be agreed with the OC
- Service personnel are allowed to work in closed service cabins without contact with locals
- Meals at the hotel will be organised and nations will be divided. Detailed plan/schedule from the OC will follow
- For the rest of the time everyone has to stay in their hotel room, without contact with other athletes, team members, locals or others

**After day 3** you are allowed to take part in official trainings and competitions. You are still in quarantine during your spare time, and have to avoid contact with locals, and can't visit shops, restaurants, city centre etc. **After day 10** you are free from quarantine.

Accreditation will be issued after a negative result from the first test.

### **Accommodation**

All teams and staff have to follow the OC accommodation system. No possibilities to stay outside of OC accommodation.

Due to our Covid-19 protocol, we are only allowed to accommodate guests in single-rooms. Please make sure to only make single-room entries through the FIS online-entry registration.

#### Costs

Additional costs for single rooms and extra nights because of the "sports quarantine" for persons within quota will be covered by the OC.

Costs for SARS-CoV-2-tests in Norway has to be covered by the respective ski federation. Prizes; Euro 100 for PCR-test and Euro 50 for Antigen test

### Other

Face masks must be used by all persons both outside and inside, except during training and competitions.

### **Transport and luggage**

Raw Air Tournament will handle the transport for all Teams according to Covid-19 restrictions. Each team will be assigned to a specific bus and have to sit on the same bus the whole tournament. To avoid crowded departure and arrival from/to the hotels a detailed time schedule for transport will follow.

Everyone has to handle their own personal luggage. The bus driver will help with loading and unloading the luggage according to Covid-19 restrictions.
