COVID-19

Competitions shall be carried out in accordance with recommendations from Polish health authorities (National Institute of Hygiene and Sanitary, Epidemiological Station), World Health Organisation and International Ski Federation.

Currently there are no restrictions for teams and officials travelling intoPoland for international sport events (no PCR, no quarantine required) provided that entering individuals are able to prove the fact of the event being held and that they are officialy entered as participating athletes/team officials, judges, accredited journalists. After name entries are submitted by given deadlines, LOC will provide each team/official with written confirmation that might be required on entering Poland.

Shall there be any updates, we will inform everybody concerned accordingly. Access to the competition venues (jumping facility as well as start and finish area) is cordoned off and controlled.

GENERAL HYGIENE RULES

- Only accredited persons are allowed access
- Persons with symptoms of infection are not allowed to enter the venue
- Only athletes and staff, officials, judges and volunteers, whose personal data are recorded, are accredited. Without accreditation, it is forbidden to enter the venues.
- Spectators are not allowed.
- Compliance with hygiene measures (hand disinfection, coughing and sneezing hygiene, minimum distance of 1.5m) must be observed. Dispensers with disinfectants for hand-disinfection are provided. The signs of the organizer at the competition venues must be observed.
- Wearing a mouth-nose-cover on the event venue is mandatory. (except for athletes for ski jumping part: mouth-nose-cover is required until the control of crotch and after leaving the exit gate.
- Wearing a mouth-nose-cover is required for the victory ceremony.

PCR TEST ON DEPARTURE

Shall there be any teams who require PCR test on departure from Poland, please inform LOC as soon as possible (office.wisla@gmail.com) so these can be arranged in time.
