Taking personal responsibility

Hygiene measures (regular hand washing, regular disinfection)

Maintain a minimum distance of 2 meter in all areas (social distancing).

Wearing mouth and nose protector (FFP2) on the entire event site.

1) Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the FIS Ski World Cup, Nordic combined triple in Seefeld must this year be held under increased health measures. Due to the current regulations of the Austrian Federal Ministry of Health and the additional measures from the Austria Ski Nordic Veranstaltungen GmbH as the organiser as well as the FIS, we will soon send you a protocol of measurements to be taken by the teams . Please forward the protocol to all team members (athletes, coaches, service people, NSA officials etc.) By registering for this event, each team member confirms and accepts the contents of this protocol of measurements for the abovementioned event in full.

2) The following information must be uploaded to the FIS passport database 12 hours before accreditations are to be collected:

- Negativ COVID-19 PCR test result including the testing data and the national laboratory certificate.
- „FIS Whereabouts“



• „FIS Health Questionnaires“

The (athletes, trainers, coaches and service people etc.) must present a negativ COVID-19 PCR test result that was carried out no longer than 72 hours previously at the time of accreditation. In case the presence at the event is equal to or longer than 6 days, taking into account the 72 hours, a new test must be implemented.

3) Remain in the assigned and marked team zones (red zone).

- The team zone (red zone) is cordoned off and only accessible to designated accredited people.
 - Avoid direct contact with other teams.
 - Avoid direct contact with employees/press.
- Mouth and nose protection (only FFP2 masks) must be worn on the event site.

Exceptions:

- During the practice of sport.
- During meal times after individuals have sat down at their tables
- At the start and warm-up area, athletes do not need mouth-and-nose protection, but mouth-and-nose protection is mandatory for all coaches/officials present.

4) Contact Tracing must be quarenteed in all accreditation zones. Each zone will have a check-in/check out system.

5) In case of symptoms immediately inform the LOC at the Single Point of Contact + 43 664 815 2990. The number is available 24 hours a day from the official arrival until the official departure. In case of symptoms, an isolation room is reserved near the event site. LOC activates the COVID-19 rescue chain . All communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with the FIS and the LOC.

Accommodation (World Cup Rules Art.13)

- Booking according the FIS Rules via FIS Online registration system.
- Bookings can only be made by the tourist board Seefeld maria.plangger@seefeld.com If information is already given before the preliminary entry date, this would be very helpful for the tourist board accommodation team.
- If you have preferred hotel, please inform the tourist board Seefeld maria.plangger@seefeld.com
- The booked hotels include full board until Thursday. Friday, Saturday and Sunday will be with half board and lunch on-site.
- Additional information about the accommodation will be given to the teams after receiving preliminary entry and accommodation request.
- Accommodation costs: The OC will pay for persons within the quoota according to FIS Rules. Costs for persons not in the quota and all extras are payable directly in the hotels.
- Check-in all team members by the team captain
- Deadline Preliminary Entry 18.12.2020 / Hard Deadline 04.01.2021. After this entry, everything that are booked will be charged. Cancellations will no longer be accepted. Only namechanges will be possible.
- Wear a mouth and nose protector in all public areas in your hotel.
- Further hygiene measures according to the hotel policy.
- Maintain social distancing in all areas.

- You will find a reserved parking area for accreditation pick-up. After picking up your accreditations, we kindly ask you to park your car at the designated parking areas.
- Due to the Covid-19 situation, the organization committee is obliged to limit the number of accredited people. Therefore **only team officials will be granted access to the team and sports relevant areas. No exceptions to this rule will be made for family members or other viewers.**
- Each team member officially named by the respective National Ski Federation via the FIS online system, must submit negative PCR test not older than 72 hours. The PCR test presented must be recognised by the health authorities in the country where the test is carried out! The test protocol must be uploaded at least 12 hours before arrival on the FIS passport.
- Each team member must also bring the health questionnaire prescribed by the FIS to the event. Only after these documents have been presented, checked and documented will the accreditations be handed over to the team captain or one nominated person.
- Only the team captain or one representative of the team may receive the accreditations collectively.
- Employees of the accreditation/racing office wear a mouth-and-nose protection or are separated by a physical barrier/screen. Everyone entering the accreditation-building must wear a face-nose-mask.
- The accreditation serves as part of our contact tracing and must be worn on your person at all times, except by athletes immediately before, during and after the competition.
- The accreditation must in no circumstances whatsoever be given to third parties.

Transport

Official airport: Munich and Innsbruck

The organizing committee will arrange transportation between the airports and the hotels. 1 transport (from and to the airport) free of charge. Only teams, no single persons! To get a smooth settlement we kindly ask you to contact the Race Office early enough to register for the transportation k.kraus@seefeld-sports.at

Transport from/to hotel-venue: Limited shuttle possible. Preferred transport in the own teams' vehicles. Only use the allocated and designated parking space for your team (red parking space (A) near the jumping area for **one** car. Further cars at the WM Halle, Möserer Straße (B). Drop-off area in the WM Arena available.

In case of COVID-19 symptoms do not travel to the venue.

Avoid stops between the departure point and the event location.

Avoid contact with other people - especially outside the team.

The TCM procedure is communicated via the FIS.



Prize Money

We kindly ask the athletes to fill in all required information (personal data, account, passport, etc.) into the FIS Data System "FIS Athlete Registration" module in the FIS member section to ensure a quick bank transfer of the prize money.

Tax will be deducted by the OC according to the Austrian Taxation and taxes will be paid by the OC according to the regular legislation in Austria.

Waxing facilities

- Wax cabins: Every nation is assigned a waxing cabin by the organiser. The keys can be picked up from the competition office. Deposit: € 50,-
- Cabins are available from Tuesday the 26th of January 2021.
- Parking space: Only one car per team is allowed to park in the WM Arena. Further cars can be parked at the second team-parking-lot next to the WM Halle. Drop-off will be allowed. This year only limited shuttle possible. Parking cards will be issued at the accreditation .
- Wax trucks: Teams arriving with trucks must inform the OC until 17.12.2020 with exact measurements of the truck and details of the needs. k.kraus@seefeld-sports.at

Please be aware that teams arriving with a wax truck will not receive any wax cabin but only changing space according to the FIS rules.

Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies

All used frequencies must be registered with and authorized by the regulatory authority. A fine up to € 4000,- may apply for unregistered radios.

Please make sure to fill in the linked registration form and send it to fb.innsbruck@bmvit.gv.at

Representatives of the authority will be on site during the World Cup to check if all radios are registered.

Regulations of Visa

- Remember that citizens of some countries will need visa to visiting Austria. Please check with your embassy if you need a visa for Austria.
