Competition Rules

FIS rules will be applied to this competition

COVID-19 SITUATION

In order to ensure the health and safety for the athletes and team personnel, the LOC is working in accordance with the Regional and National Health regulations as well as with FIS in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines together with the World Health Organisation (WHO) information and recommendations. The LOC and FIS Event Task Force has been established and is monitoring all developments. The corresponding arrangements are currently being put together in a separate document. This will be published and communicated by the LOC at a later stage. All competitors must have their own medical insurance (ICR art 212) which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment expenses. Updated COVID-19 relevant medical procedures that may be required will be communicated whenever relevant.

Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants as per rule 4.2 in the Rules for the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cups.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than the 30th of December, 2020 as per rule 4.2.1 in the Rules for the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cups.

Access to the online registration system is through FIS Homepage http://www.fis-ski.com then go to Member Section.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Snowboard Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded:

Accomodation and Wax Rooms

Teams will be hosted for lodging and meals at different partner hotels as per the FIS Snowboard World Cup rules (7 nights at the FIS rate, CHF 80,-) from Sunday January 10th to Sunday January 17th. Earlier arrivals or later departures than the official arriving/departure day do not guarantee the FIS rate. Tourism tax is between € 1,80 and € 2,40 per night and person.

As per the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cup Rules on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials will pay the Euro equivalent of 80 Swiss Francs per day. The tourism tax has to be paid extra (between € 1,80 and € 2,40 per night and person). Each coach has to pay his/her team accommodation expenses on arrival day. No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. Wax rooms will be at all partner hotels.

Cancellation before one week of competition day are free of charge. Cancellation 6 days or less before the competition day can be charged individually by the hotel.

Registration / Race Office

Team registration will take place daily starting on Sunday 10th January at the Haus of Gastes. This year, we need a profile photo from every athlete, coach and professional man in advance for personalized accreditation. The accreditation can also be established on site. To do this, however, every athlete, coach and serviceman must visit the accreditation office personally. Haus des Gastes, Silvrettastrasse 6, 6780 Schruns.

Participation Fee

According to the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cup Rules (art 4.4) a mandatory total Participation Fee of CHF 90 per each competitor, official training, qualification and competition day has to be paid to the organizing committee.

Payment

The Participation Fee has to be paid at the Alpine Sport Center in cash or credit card.

TC Meetings

The Team Captains meeting will be in Haus des Gastes, Silvrettastrasse 6, 6780 Schruns. Please see the schedule for meeting times. First TC Meeting will be on Sunday 10th January. If necessary the TCM will take place digital by Zoom.











Medical and Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping control testing maybe conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

FIS Licence

All athletes are required to have a valid FIS license.

Press Center

The Press Center will be located at the Alpine Sport Center

Ceremonies, Public Draw, Side Events

Please see schedule for the Ceremonies, Public Draw & Side Events times. The competitors MUST wear bibs during the official training, competition and prize giving ceremony! Top 3 women and top 3 men need to attend the award ceremony right after the final run in the finish area.

Accreditation

The accreditation will take place daily starting on Sunday 10th January at the Race Office, which is located at the Haus des Gastes, Silvrettastrasse 6, 6780 Schruns. Please send us pictures of athlete, coach and staff (photo&name) to prepare the Accreditation. Deadline: 30th December 2020

Rules

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule of the event stated in the program, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.

Bibs

The competitors must wear bibs during trainings, competition and award ceremonies. Please note that there will be a deposit of € 20,- for each bib, payable in cash at the race office.

Transportations/Directions

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.











PRIZE MONEY

New: the prize money will be transferred to the athlete account. Prize money document enclosed needs to be filled out correct. Each team captain is responsible for ensuring that the prize money document has been completed correctly. With the prize money document and a valid travel document of the respective athlete, the prize money can be received in the race office.
