# GENERAL INFORMATION

On behalf of Corvatsch ski resort we are pleased to invite all teams to attend the FIS Snowboard World Cup Slopestyle in Silvaplana.

The event starts on Wednesday, March 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 with the first training day. Thursday, March 25<sup>th</sup> is the second training day. Qualification takes place on Saturday, March 27<sup>th</sup> (women) and Sunday, March 28<sup>th</sup> 2021 (men) and the finals take place on Sunday, March 28<sup>th</sup> 2021.

## WORLD CUP EVENT/ ENTRIES

### DEADLINE ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Association according to the FIS quotas and rules. The number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the name of participants must be submitted to the Organizing Committee within the following deadlines:

Preliminary and Final Deadline **March, 3<sup>rd</sup> 2021.**

### IMPORTANT:

Seen the last minute replacement the entry/ranking file from Spindleruv CZE will be used as a reference for the Silvaplana Snowboard SS World Cup. Only adjustment is the add of the Swiss host nation quotas. In this way we don't penalize those whom have already entered ,booked flights and confirmed the presence to such WC date. Silvaplana (1815m) with its ski resort Corvatsch (up to 3303m) is located in the Engadine, Switzerland. Engadine is a famous valley in the Southern Alps with a long skiing tradition and St. Moritz as its main town. **Corvatsch goal is to establish an outstanding freestyle event in the Engadine valley.** The slopestyle course will be located at 2700m high altitude.

# TRANSPORT

Teams are responsible for their own transport. There are several airports in more or less the same distance to Engadine valley: **Zurich** (CH); **Milan** (IT); and **Innsbruck** (AT).

All these airports are 3 to 3.5 hours car driving to Silvaplana. If you are travelling with public transport, it is preferable to choose Zurich airport (4 hours travel by train).

From Zurich airport you can find the best connection to the final train station St. Moritz on the website <https://www.sbb.ch/en/home.html>. From the train station to your accommodation there is a taxi service in front of the train station as well as a bus service (the timetable is available on the same website by entering the accommodation address).

# REQUIREMENTS COVID-19

All teams will be informed on the exact procedures for entering Switzerland from abroad, travelling to the event and the requirements during the event later on.

# ONSITE ACCREDITATION

The onsite accreditation starts on **Tuesday, 23<sup>rd</sup> of March 2021**. The opening time and the exact location of the registration desk will be communicated later on to all teams.

# ADMINISTRATION FEE

Every competitor has to pay **CHF 120 administration fee** at the registration. The payment can be made with credit card or cash (Swiss Francs only).

# LIFT TICKETS

All athletes and coaches will get **free lift tickets during the World Cup week: from Tuesday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> to Sunday, March 28<sup>nd</sup> 2021**.
