Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Snowboard World Cup in Berchtesgaden organised from 18th to 21st March 2021 has to take place under tight security measures. We kindly ask you to forward the following information and rules to all team members (athletes, coaches, staff, etc.) who register for the event via FIS platform. By registering for this event, each team member fully confirms and accepts the content of this catalogue of measures for the above-mentioned event.

Hygiene concept for the competitions “Snowboard World cup Berchtesgaden” from 18th to 21st March 2021

Basics:

Participation in the competitions is only possible with a negative PCR Covid19 test result. The negative PCR Covid-19 test results, the whereabouts for defined period (14 days) and Pre Event health questionnaire must be available to the organization team via the **FIS Passport System** before issuing the accreditation (from Thursday 18.03.2021 from 14:00h). There are 5 accreditation groups:

Red = Race / Blue= Organisation / Yellow= Presse / Green= Piste / Black (race office) = coach, FIS, Timing

All coaches, staff and officials will be informed about the applicable hygiene regulations in the team leader meeting before the competition and also in the written invitation.

As event-organizer, we are obliged to limit the number of accredited people due to the COVID-19 situation. Therefore, only team officials are admitted to team and sports relevant areas, in line with the respective FIS quotas. People beyond the applicable FIS quota are not allowed.

Team Captains Meeting:

The team captains meeting will be held online. The link is visible in the invitation to competition. The jury and the chief of timing centrally chair the team captains meeting with mouth-nose cover. The contact details of the organisation team will be noted in the invitation to competition. The bibs are hung up on a beam in front of the function building, and the bib is collected and returned by the athlete directly before and after the respective race. Freshly disinfected start numbers are used for each competition.

Hygienic Measures:

During the entire competition, the minimum distance requirement must be followed, all coaches, athletes and officials must wear a medical mouth-nose cover. Exceptions for athletes only during the warm-up run and the race, as well as during the immediate preparation for the start.

Communication:

The communication is carried out via messenger services (connection coach WC). The start and result lists in paper form are printed only for the jury and the organisation team. No times are written on the timetable, no lists of results are displayed. Program changes, start lists, intermediate information, disqualifications and result lists are made available online.

Only the coaches (1 per Nation), the jury and the organisation team are allowed to enter the function building (race office, time keeping room)

Race area:

The race area is closed off in such a way that only authorised persons are allowed access. The competition takes place without spectators. A congregation of people must be avoided. This may be announced via loudspeakers. A medical mouth and nose cover must be worn in all areas of the ski lift and the competition areas. The start and finish area is closed off as wide as possible to ensure the necessary distance of the athletes and coaches.

The starter and the starter judge must wear a mouth-nose cover in form of an FFP2/KN95 mask. The competition will be conducted rapidly in compliance with all necessary safety guidelines.

Award Ceremony:

The award ceremony will take place as soon as possible after the end of the race in the open area. A presentation of the prizes will not take place. Prizes will be placed on a podium and picked up by the winners themselves.

The organiser reserves his right to make consistent use of his domiciliary rights against persons who do not comply with the regulations. A breach of the Covid 19 protocol and the discipline protocol will lead directly to withdrawal of the accreditation
