REGISTRATION

Teams/Athletes registration will take place on Wednesday, February 10th 2021 from 9:00 to 18:00 at the Race office (Consorzio Turistico Sondrio e Valmalenco, loc. Vassalini 23023 Chiesa in Valmalenco).

ACCOMMODATION

According to FIS Rules, it is possible to book the accommodation through the Organizing Committee at the fixed price of € 65,00/person/day in half board treatment in one of the 3* hotels in Valmalenco.

Accommodation will be provided for the nights starting from Wednesday, February 10th to Sunday, February 14th 2021 included. Please send the accommodation form to raceoffice@sondrioevalmalenco.it

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, minibar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes.

We remind you that, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, in Lombardy bars and restaurants are closed after 18:00. We therefore suggest you to book your accommodation in a hotel, as bars and restaurants are only permitted to provide takeaway and delivery, while hotels are allowed to serve dinner to their clients.

ENTRIES

Entries will only be accepted from National Snowboard Associations in accordance with FIS quotas and rules. All entries must be submitted by sending the entry form via email to raceoffice@sondrioevalmalenco.it

According to FIS Snowboard EC rules, each competitor has to pay an **entry fee of CHF 50,00** for each competition day (= € 46,00: currency exchange rate on the day of publishing this team invitation) – lift pass not included.

The **lift pass** for team members will be sold at the special price of € 27,00/day.

Entry fees must be paid directly to the Organizing Committee Valmalenco at the Race office when collecting the accreditations (Consorzio Turistico Sondrio e Valmalenco, loc. Vassalini 23023 Chiesa in Valmalenco).



COVID-19 PREVENTION GUIDELINES

JOURNEY TO VALMALENCO

- Refrain from travelling to the venue if you have symptoms of Covid-19.
- If people close to you have been affected with Covid-19, please contact your superior and refrain from travelling to the venue.
- Avoid contact with people not belonging to your team or "bubble".

C-19 PREVENTION ON SITE

- Always wear a face mask in the entire event area, indoors, outdoors, when riding on the cable car and on private and public means of transportation.
- Keep a minimum distance of one meter from other people.
- Wash and disinfect your hands frequently.
- Do a daily health self-assessment. If you experience any symptoms of illness, please report
 your medical condition to the OC and stay out of the competition area, in order to prevent a
 possible Covid spread.
- It is highly recommended to download the national contact tracing app "Immuni".

ACCREDITATION

- Given the current circumstances, accreditations are only issued to team members, staff and other necessary service providers.
- In order to get the accreditation, each participant must perform negative PCR or antigene test within 72 hrs prior to the arrival in Chiesa in Valmalenco OR, in case a participant has had Covid-19 from 14 to 90 days prior to the arrival, he/she must submit a valid antibodies positive serological blood test performed before the arrival. The testing certificate must be issued by laboratories accredited by the respective National Ministries of Health. The LOC, in accordance with the Italian Authorities and considering the evolution of the COVID-19 pandemic, reserves the right not to accept tests produced by certain countries, in particular non-Schengen countries.
- Only one representative per team may collect all accreditations for the whole team at the race office.
- Athletes, coaches, staff and service providers must always carry their accreditations with them, so that our staff can identify them. Otherwise access to the lift, slopes etc. will be prohibited.

A breach of the prevention guidelines will lead to withdrawal of the accreditation.
