

1. COMPETITION RULES

FIS rules will apply to this competition.

2. ENTRIES

Entries will only be accepted from National Snowboard Associations in accordance with FIS quotas and rules. All entries must be submitted through the FIS online registration system (http://www.fis-ski.com/ "Member section").

Final entries (including competitors and officials) must be submitted by 12th January 2021.















3. EVENT FEE

According to the FIS Snowboard WC rules, a mandatory participation fee of CHF 30 per training and competition day per competitor has to be paid to the OC.

4. ACCOMMODATION

As per the FIS rule on accommodation, each team member/participant (athletes, coaches, skimen, physiotherapists, staff etc.) will pay 80 CHF per day/person directly to the organizers.

Accommodation at the FIS rate will be provided for the nights of Thursday 21st, Friday 22nd, Saturday 23rd and Sunday 24th January 2021.

Further details regarding the half board accommodations will be communicated nearer the event date.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Team accommodation will be confirmed nearer the time.



8. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all competitions and award ceremonies. The same bibs shall be used from the draw until the end of the race and the award ceremony. A € 100,00 deposit per team has to be paid cash to the organizers.













9. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Each competitor must have his/her own Insurance. The Organizing Committee, Sci club F.A.B. Snow Eagle, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

10. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Sci club F.A.B. Snow Eagle, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

11. ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping controls may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.









12. PRIZE MONEY





The total prize purse for the FIS Snowboard World Cup is 50,000 CHF (25,000 CHF for men, 25,000 CHF for ladies). Prize money will be given in Euros and may be subject to Italian withholding tax. Prize money will be transferred to the athletes accounts within 7 days from the last competition day.

The detailed protocol of measures for the mitigation of the Covid-19 infection risk will be available nearer the event date.

To get the accreditation, you must exhibit a certificate proving that you have performed a negative swab test within 72 hours prior to your arrival in Chiesa in Valmalenco. Teams from non-Schengen Nations and Countries considered at high risk of contagion by the Italian Authorities, may be asked also for a negative swab test certificate performed in the 8-10 days prior to arrival in Chiesa in Valmalenco. The testing certificate must be issued by laboratories accredited by the respective National Ministries of Health. The LOC, in accordance with the Italian Authorities and considering the evolution of the COVID-19 pandemic, reserves the right not to accept tests produced by certain countries, in particular non-Schengen countries.

Access to the accreditation and race office, as well as to the Teams Captains Meetings is allowed only to one representative per Nation.

The accommodation facilities in Chiesa in Valmalenco are already setup to host athletes and teams, according to the guidelines of the Lombardia Region and the FIS.

On the day of the race there will be restrictions on access to the lifts. Routes and spaces dedicated to athletes and teams will be prepared.

In any case it is the responsibility of every person to adhere to the policy, follow all procedures and instructions and behave in a disciplined manner at all times.
