COVID-19 Health, Safety and

Race bubble testing protocol

Teams, FIS, Media, Judges

To get the accreditation you need:

1. Present the results: 1. For a PCR test conducted within 72 hours prior to arrival in Russia. The results must appear in one's FIS PASSPORT 12 hours before the accreditation retrieval area opens for the race sanitary bubble so that the COVID-19 medical coordinator can review them. 2. Fill out the FIS questionnaire. To process your FIS passport: <https://fispasport.fis-ski.com/fis>

After the race you can be tested to join the upcoming WC event. The costs of testing will be covered by the teams representatives. The detailed information will be provided on TCM.

Before the race you can be tested starting from 28 of January. The costs of the testing around 50 euro per person will be covered by the teams representatives. The detailed information and testing schedule will be provided upon arrival.



The previously infected person is allowed to join the competition after the 14 days quarantine completed and with the negative PCR test provided

Health protocol and hygiene

1. Wearing the mouth and nose protector (face mask) is obligatory on the entire event side, in the rest rooms, using all type of transfers, cars, buses, gondolas, chair lifts, in the common areas of the hotel with the exception for the mealtimes and for the training/competition.

2. Staying in a city please follow the rules of the social distancing (2 meters), do not use the public transport and try to avoid the shopping centers visiting.

3. Regular hand washing or hand sanitizing is necessary.

4. All the participants, judges, organizers and other persons at the entrance to the Venue as well as accommodation area, will undergo the thermometry procedure by noncontact means.



Entering the country and accreditation



To board on the plane to Russia all the foreign citizens are obliged to provide a printed medical document (in English or Russian) confirming the **negative PCR test result for COVID-19** which was made not earlier than 72 hours prior their arrival in Russia.



The document may also be issued in the official language of the country with a notarized Russian translation in the Consular of Russian Federation



Please note, that the document must be printed out. SMS or any other forms on a mobile device will not be accepted on the border.



Action protocol in case of COVID related symptoms



All the participants, judges, Media, FIS representatives and other officials will undergo the thermometry procedure by non contacts means.

If there is person running high temperature (norm fever till 37.1 -37.2) information about this case will be passed over to the LOC COVID coordinator, the person will undergo the thermometry for the second time either at the venue medical room or by the Competition doctor.

If the second thermometry will show the high temperature, the person is advised to take a control PCR test at his own expense at one of the licensed express laboratory in Moscow.

If the control test shows a positive COVID-19 result, the person will be isolated in a separate room in the hotel and emergency team will be called to take the person to the Clinic. The extra expenses for the lodging in case of isolation will be covered by the team representatives.

If there is evidence of an acute infection you will be provided with a mask, the medical personnel are equipped and isolation will be required. The local public health authority will be notified, and their protocols will be followed. An accreditation will not be issued until you have been cleared by the local public health authority.

Athletes and accredited persons should be reassured that declaring travel from high risk area will not preclude participation, but that they should expect to be more closely monitored.

The personal information provided is treated strictly confidentially by the Local Organising Committee and FIS. It will only be used for the purpose of assessing whether the applicant can be granted or maintain accreditation in view of the COVID-19 outbreak. Local and global public health requirements will determine the length of time the data is retained.
