Dear Snowboard Friends!

Welcome to the **FIS Snowboard Europa Cup Big Air**
to be held on the 25th - 28th of February 2021 at the historic location of Vorobiovy Gory, Moscow!

Russian Snowboard Federation will host the event in accordance with the FIS International Competition Rules (ICR) and FIS Continental Cups Rules. All athletes who are qualified according to the FIS Rules for the Snowboard Europa Cup are invited to take part in the competition.

1. PASSPORT and VISA

A foreign visitor traveling to Russia must have a passport **valid for at least next 6 months after the date of departure from Russia.**

In order to receive a visa invitation, please provide the following information:

- a scanned copy of passport in good quality;
- Russian Consulate of which city you are planning on applying for visa at.

Please note: Russian Consulates usually also require that any foreign visitor travelling to Russia should have a valid travel insurance (for action sports and/or professional/competitive sports).

2. Entry Forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski and Snowboard Associations in accordance with the FIS quotas and FIS Continental Cup Rules. Please use the official entry form (ICR art. 215).

3. Event Participation Fee

According to the FIS SB Continental Cup Rule (EC 2.6) a Participation Fee of **CHF 50** per each competitor, covering both training and competition days, will be charged.

This amount has to be paid to the Organizing Committee at the registration at the Race Office starting on Thursday, February 25th, 2021

Please note: Payments will be accepted only in cash!

Euros, Swiss Francs, and Rubles will be accepted but change will be given in Rubles.



4. Registration

Team registration will take place starting on Thursday, February 25th, 2021, at the Race Office.

5. Accommodation

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation (double room, half-board), each participant will pay a maximum of **CHF 80** per day/person.

The amount is payable upon registration at the Race Office.

The official hotel of the event is the Azimut Tulskeya Hotel.

Accommodation at FIS rate will be provided from arrival on Thursday, **February 25th, 2021**, until departure on Sunday, **February 28th, 2021**.

*Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay.

*The OC will provide accommodation guidance for those who arrive before February 25th, 2021.

6. Ground Transportation

The Organizing Committee will organize transport (shuttle buses) from the airport to the official hotel Azimut Tulskeya, as well as shuttle buses to the competition venue and back to the official hotel.

7. Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be organized at the hotel starting with dinner on Thursday **February 25th, 2021** and finishing with breakfast on Sunday, **February 28th, 2021**.

8. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all official trainings, competitions and award ceremonies.

9. Accident insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, Russian Snowboard Federation, sponsors, suppliers, their agents and the FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

10. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Event Organizing Committee, «Vorobiovy Gory» Sports Complex, Russian Snowboard Federation, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athletes, officials or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

11. COVID-19 Protection and Safety Event Protocol and Host Nation Regulations

All competitors, coaches and staff are strictly obliged to conform with the **Event COVID-19 Protocol** (Please see details, regulations and instructions in **ANNEX 1**)

Printed Official Hardcopy Medical confirmation paper has to be obtained by ALL foreign participants of the Event – no less within 72 hours BEFORE entering the Russian Federation!



11. Official Notice Board

The official notice board will be located at the Race Office at the Azimut Tulskeya Hotel.

12. Competition and Training Schedule

Training and Competition times are according to the official sports schedule of the event.

13. Prize Money

Total of EUR 15 000 (Men EUR 10 000, Ladies EUR 5 000).

14. Announcements

An English-speaking announcer & rider-service staff will be provided by the OC for the event.

15. Medical and Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control may be conducted on location - as requested by official Doping Control officers for each gender of competitors.
