Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski and Snowboard Associations following FIS World Cup quotas and rules. Please submit the provisional entry with anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by 30th November 2020. The final entry with number of your competition team and names of participants (including competitors and official) must be submitted to the organizers no later than 30th December, 2020.

Onsite registration / Accreditation

Registration and accreditation will be held at the accreditation office in the Seminar Room of the Hotel Belvédère, Stradun 330, the office is signed, in Scuol. Please see schedule for registration times. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the registration area for check-in before proceeding to the competition venues. All fees will be collected upon check-in.

Athlete Participation Fee: CHF 30.00 per competitor only cash and credit card can be accepted at accreditation office.

Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during competition and at the awards ceremony.

Early arrivals or later departures are subject to availability, prices depend on each hotel.

Teams must submit their expected total number of team members (competitors, coaches and team officials) and accommodation needs no later than 30th November 2020. Final accommodation reservations must be booked no later than 30th December, 2020.

Waxing facilities

Waxing rooms in team hotels or near by, if no waxing room in team hotel.

Prize money / awards ceremony

Main awards ceremony right after finals at finish area.

A total prize purse of CHF 50'000.00 (CHF 25'000.00 per gender event) will be awarded for the FIS Snowboard World Cup Scuol. The winners will receive prize money via bank transfer. In order to process the prize money all winners must provide valid bank details, identification, and complete appropriate tax documentation. Athletes must go to registration office, located in the Seminar Room of the Hotel Belvédère in Scuol, immediately following awards on finals to claim prize money.

Covid – 19 Prevention Guide Lines

The detailed protocol of measures for the mitigation of the Covid-19 infection risk will be available one month before the event.

To get the accreditation, you must exhibit a certification proving that you have a negative swab test within 72 hours prior to your arrival in Scuol. Teams from non-Schengen Nations and Countries considered at high risk contagion by the Swiss Authorities, may be asked also for a negative swab test certificate performed in the 8-10 days prior to arrival in Scuol.

The testing certificate must be issued by laboratories accredited by the respective National

Ministries of Health. The LOC, in accordance with the swiss Authorities and considering the evolution of the COVID-19 pandemic, reserves the right not to accept tests produced by certain countries, in particular non-Schengen countries.

Access to the accreditation and race office, as well as to the Teams Captain Meetings is allowed only to the representative per Nation.

The accommodation facilities in Scuol are already set up to host athletes and teams, according to the guidelines of the Hotellerie Suisse.

On the day of the race there will be restrictions on access to the lifts. Routes and spaces dedicated to athletes and teams will be prepared.

In any case it is the responsibility of every person to adhere to the policy, always follow all procedures and instructions and behave in a disciplined manner.

A breach of discipline protocol will lead to withdraw af accreditation, such as going to locations with others present that are not subject to the protocol, i.e. bars, hotspots during the Event.

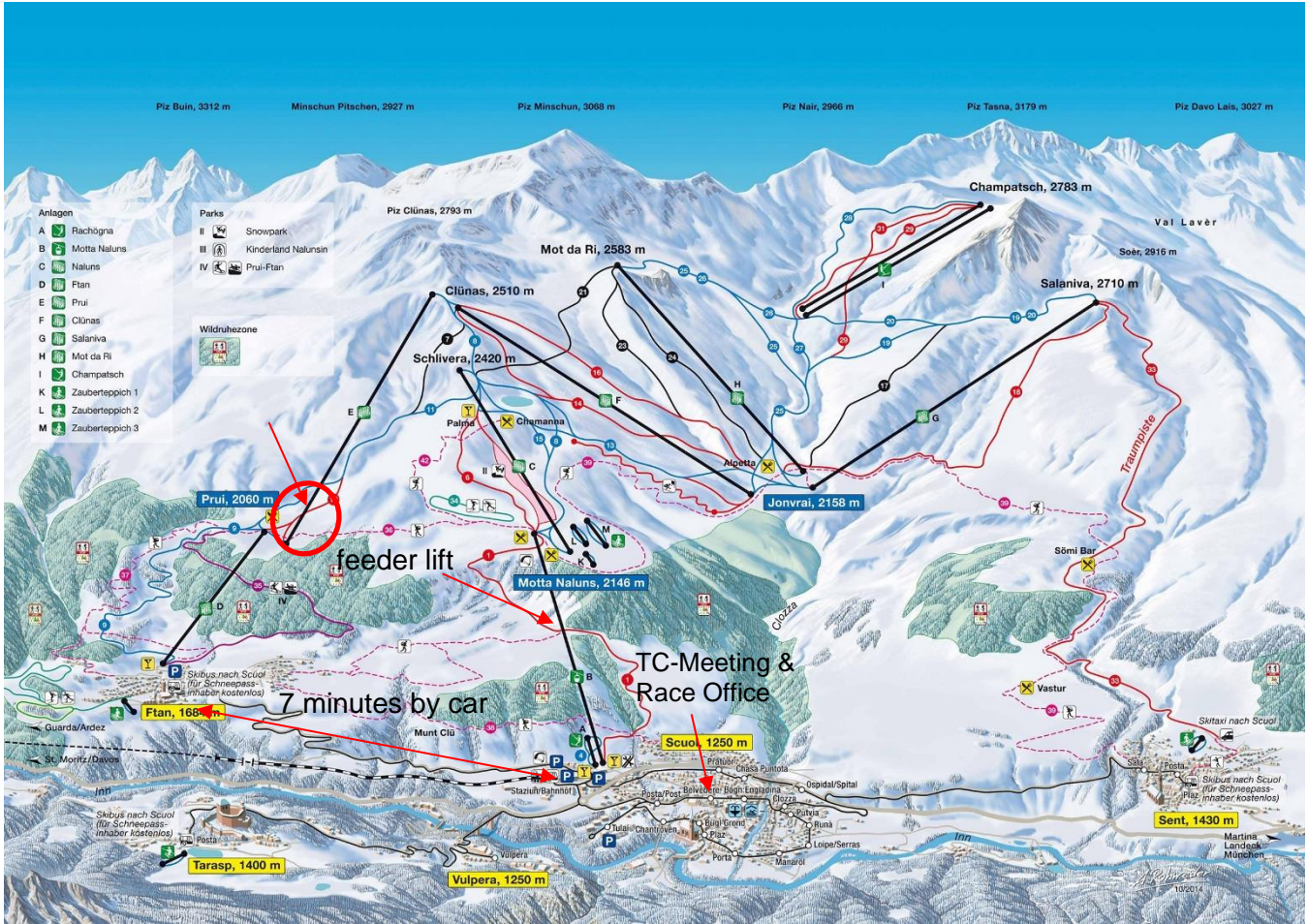
