2. RULES

The Austrian Ski Federation and the Crosspark Committee are organising the 2 FIS races.

The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.

This competition is a Snowboard Cross event and is open to both men and women

This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants

The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, or by the decision of the competition jury.

3. ENTRIES

4. REGISTRATION AND MEANS OF PAYMENT

Attention: We only accept payment by card (also for coaches and staff)!

The entry fee must be paid by card when you pick up your bib number.

Bib numbers will be issued outdoors at the cash desk on the day of the event. The bib numbers are picked up by 1 representative from each team in order to restrict the movement of people.

Entry & ticket fee:

2 races per athlete, CHF 150 incl. Training-Day + € 20 Depot bib number

According to the FIS rules:

- 1 > 3 competitors: 3 officials or accompanying persons
- 4 > 8 competitors: 5 officials or accompanying persons
- 9 & more: 6 officials or accompanying persons

€ 39,50 per day for all other coaches, officials & accompanying persons

7. ACCREDITATION

Everyone (athletes, coaches and employees) who would like to receive accreditation for the event must present a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR or Rapid Antigen Test), which must not be older than 72 hours before the first start of the competition.

Entering the race area is only possible with a valid accreditation.

People with a previously diagnosed COVID-19 infection must present the positive COVID-19 test result (PCR), which is between 2 weeks and 3 months old, at the time of accreditation and must be free of COVID-19 symptoms at least 3 days before arrival.

8. BIBS AND HELMETS

It is mandatory for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A penalty will be charged to every competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will have to pay a € 20,- deposit per bib. The deposit will be refund at the end of the competition when bibs are returned.

9. LIABILITY

All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organising Committee, Reiteralm, the Austrian Ski Federation, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries occurred or suffered by competitors, officials or any other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

10. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee, Reiteralm, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation will not be held responsible for accidents and, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

11. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.

DUE TO COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

We would like to inform you about our FIS races which will take place from 22nd January 2021 – 24th January 2021 at the Crosspark Reiteralm. Through the strict regulations from our government for preventing COVID 19 infections, negative COVID-19 test results (PCR or Rapid Antigen) for every participant and coaches are required prior the event. Everybody has to present a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR or Antigen), which must not be older than 72 hours before the first start of the competition, otherwise its it not allowed to use the gondola and to join the race area.

As part of the event, a Covid 19 prevention concept will be drawn up in cooperation with the ÖSV and regional authorities, and a Covid 19 officer has been appointed.

FFP2 masks are mandatory in the gondola and in closed rooms. In all other areas, mouth and nose protection must be worn.

The races will be closed to the spectators - just participate athletes and responsible team coaches allowed to stay at event facilities.

Every race day, every athlete and coach must complete the registration and health questionnaire before using the following link to go to the location of the race.
