Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

#### How to get to Kopaonik

a) By airplane:

There is an international airport in Belgrade (250km away from Kopaonik).

- b) By car:
  - cc 650 km from Zagreb.
  - cc 350 km from Sarajevo

#### 6. Bibs

All teams must wear bibs during the competition and the award ceremony. Teams have to return bibs after race to a responsible person at the exit gate. Deposit of 10 EUR per Team will be collected during bib distribution.

#### 7. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee sponsors, suppliers, Snowpark Kopaonik, the FIS and the Serbian Ski Association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

#### 8. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Snowpark Kopaonik, the Serbian Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

#### 9. Event fee

Only for competition days an event fee of €20 per competitor/per race is charged, to be paid at the bibs distribution place, prior to the event. Lift tickets (bibs) are included for competition days, (free for Coaches).

#### 10. Prizes

1st - 3rd place receives medals

Prize giving ceremony: 30 minutes after the end of the races.

#### Covid19 - Travel Advisory

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY INTO THE REPUBLIC OF SERBIA

To prevent import of infectious diseases onto the territory of the Republic of Serbia, individuals coming to the Republic of Serbia from all countries across the world, **excluding the Republic of** 











#### Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Republic of Bulgaria,

Republic of North Macedonia, Montenegro and Hungary, shall be allowed to enter the Republic of Serbia solely provided they have a negative RT-PCR test to the virus SARS-CoV-2, not older than 48 hours, issued by a referential laboratory of the country they are coming from, that is the country they are entering the Republic of Serbia from. For persons arriving to Serbia from the United States a negative Antigen FIA Rapidtest is accepted, under the same conditions, instead of a negative RT-PCR test. Should there be a delay when entering the Republic of Serbia that cannot be attributed to the passenger but to an existence of an extraordinary occurrence that could not have been foreseen, avoided or discarded (delay/postponement of flight, bus or train departure, or similar event), then the test cannot be older than 72 hours when entering the Republic of Serbia.

PCR Test for traveling back to your country can be done at Public Health Center in Novi Pazar (60 km from Ski Resort Kopaonik, 1:30h of driving). Public Health center is open at working days from 07AM till 11AM. PCR results will be sent to your e-mail, next day. Price is 18.000,00 RSD (cc 160 EUR).

Accreditation/team captain information	Each team is responsible for ensuring that the information is circulated within their team and for compliance with the protection regulations.  Visitors have no access to the competition area					
Accommodation	In accordance with FOPH guidelines for the hotel industry.					
Food/meal times	In accordance with FOPH guidelines for the hotel industry and the respective catering provider/institution.					
Conduct at the competition site	Registered team members can access the competition grounds subject to compliance with the applicable codes of conduct and protective measures. Access control in consultation with the OC.  Social distancing rules must be observed at the start area, at course inspection and at the finish area. Start line judges must wear masks.					
Start numbers	Start numbers are deposited at start number stands and must be personally collected and returned.					
Award ceremony	Masks must be worn during the award ceremony.					
Communication	All registered teams will be contacted by the OC at their registered address and sent the program and protection concept.					
Protective equipment	All participants and visitors are responsible for their own protective equipment (masks, disinfectants) and will bring these with them themselves.					
Contact tracing	The list with contact details of team captains must be stored until 14 days after the event and must be identifiable at the request of the cantonal health authorities.
