INFORMATION COVID 19

We ask all athletes, coaches and officials to comply with the current protective measures regarding Covid-19. Any violation may lead to exclusion from the event. The current protection concepts and rules of conduct for all Snowboard Germany events can be found [here](#). Factsheet on information about entering Germany and local restrictions as well as the guidelines can be found [here](#)

In advance of event:

1. Do not attend if you feel sick or experience any typical symptoms of the coronavirus (such as respiratory problems, slight or heavy fever, loss of smell and/or taste or other flu-like symptoms) within 10 days ahead of the event.
2. Do not attend if you are tested positive for the coronavirus within 14 days ahead of the event.
3. Do not attend if spent more than 24 hours in a state or area with an increased risk of infection as defined by the FOPH (Federal Office of Public Health) within the last 10 days ahead of the event. Exceptions are transit passenger (=stay/layover less than 24 hours).
4. Snowboard Germany needs to know the names as well as the contact data of all coaches, physios, technicians etc., who will attend the event in advance (online registration!). No online registration = no access to the event area

During the event:

5. In general: Observe a distance of at least 1.5 meters! Wear a mask if this distance cannot be observed!
6. The race office as well as in the marked start, course and finish area has a general mask obligation! (Exceptions:athletes may take off the mask for their runs)
7. Do not mix up with other teams/nations if not mandatory!

After the event:

8. Inform Florian Heymann (head of project, +49 179 108 6174) if you test positive for the coronavirus within 10 days
