GUIDELINES AND PROTOCOLS ETABLISHED BY FFS – applicable from 1st january 2021

HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

The following protocols were established by the **French Ski Federation**, working closely with the national (**Health Ministry, Sport Ministry,** and **ARS** - the **Regional Health Agency**).

The protocol guidelines are as follows:

- Redaction, by the Organizing Committee, of a list with contact details postal mail and phone number of the racers, staff members and officials.
- Limit as much physical contact and interaction as possible by establishing sanitary bubbles.
- Adhere to physical distancing protocols and protective measures everywhere.
- Wearing a mask is required at all times, in every area both indoors and outside.
- A policy of tests:
 - nasal RT-PCR tests for race bubble, performed no later than 72 h prior to the declared arrival on site by the team captain or racers. Possibility to add 24h to this duration if the test has to be done on a Sunday or public holiday. Results have to be sent by mail to the organizers, with pmartin@ffs.fr in copy for men races and jmagnellet@orange.fr for women races, if possible 24 h before the first race.
 - provision of antigen tests in any case of doubts or symptoms.
 - antigen tests encouraged for organizers bubble
- Obligation, for all the race bubble, to send the « Contact sheet » (annex n°1) and he FIS questionnaire (annex n°2) to the organizers, the day before the arrival, on the mail address given by the organizers.
 - The French Ski Federation recommends that all people working at the event download the **TOUSANTICOVID** mobile app and get a flu vaccination shot.

HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS by zone

Accommodations & Meals:



- Establishment of a Recalls Book for the contact tracing
- If possible, a separate and specific entrance for the team.
- Teams housed on the same floor, access to the hotel's amenities using the stairs (to avoid the elevators), try to keep the teams separate from the hotel's other guests.
- Maintain appropriate distancing between twin beds.
- ❖ An additional cleaning / disinfection schedule before their arrival.
- ❖ Do not clean rooms when team members are present (avoid all contact with housekeeping personnel).
- Make isolation rooms available if needed.
- Rules for using shared facilities (gym, meeting rooms).
- Make sure that there is the required space between the team's dining room / dining areas from the other hotel guests.
- Prepare the dining room / dining areas before the teams arrive.
- Avoid buffet-style meals.
- Use a table service or self service system with meals already on plates.
- Enough water/beverages already at each table.

Ventilate any and all enclosed spaces
