Competition rules:

Actual FIS Rules will be applied to this competition. The seeding will be organized with time trials. The OC will decide the final-brackets due to the number of competitors. Changes will be announced during the teamcaptain-meeting.

Entries – Event Fee:

Entries will be accepted only from National Ski & Snowboard Associations in accordance to the FIS quotas and the rules of the IWO and must be submitted to Günther Pfefferkorn on the official FIS Entry Form per mail:

Entries Deadline: 03.03.2021 12:00 am

Entry Fee: 120.-€ / 3 days (training on friday and two competition days)

25.-€ / lift ticket per day for all team members!

Accommodation:

According to FIS Rules, it is possible to book the accommodation through the Organizing Committee at the fixed price of € 80,00/person/day in half board treatment in one of the hotels in Montafon. Accommodation will be provided for the nights starting from Thursday, March 4th to Sunday, March 07th 2021 included. Earlier arrivals or later departures than the official arriving/departure day do not guarantee the FIS rate. The tourism tax has to be paid extra (between € 1,80 and € 2,40 per night and person).

To reserve your rooms all teams need to contact Mrs. Sonja Nessler at Montafon Tourism directly (rennbuero@montafon.at or +43 50 6686 502). Cancellation before one week of competition day are free of charge. Cancellation 6 days or less before the competition day can be charged individually by the hotel.

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, minibar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes. Two single rooms per country will be provided at the official FIS-Rate (EUR 80,00/person/night). Further single rooms are possible after consultation with Mrs. Sonja Nessler at the usual hotel price.

We remind you that restaurants and bars are currently closed in Austria due to the Covid-19 pandemic. This also applies to the restaurants in the ski area.

Accident insurance and protocol:

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee and the Austrian Ski Federation will not be held responsible for accidents and damaged equipment during the training and competitions. In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.

Liability:

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event, will do it on their own risk. The Organizing Comitee, the ski area, sponsors, suppliers, FIS, ÖSV and the SkiClub Montafon are not responsible for any losses or injuries during the event days. Every participate has to sign the FIS athletes declaration.















COVID-19 Prevention guidelines:

Through the strict regulations from our government for preventing COVID 19 infections, negative COVID-19 test results (PCR or Rapid Antigen) for every participant, coaches, team member are required prior the event. Everybody has to submit a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR or Antigen) per mail to rennen@scmontafon.at before the first TC meeting starts. At this point the test result must not be older than 48 hours. Otherwise no accreditation for the race area will be issued for this person. As part of the event, a Covid 19 prevention concept will be drawn up in cooperation with the ÖSV and regional authorities, and a Covid 19 officer has been appointed. FFP2 masks are mandatory in the gondolas and in the entire event area. The races will be closed to the spectators - just participate athletes and responsible team coaches allowed to stay at event facilities. Every athlete and coach needs to do the registration & health questionnaire every race day before heading up to the race venue with link below:

- Submit the confirmation of the Covid test per mail to rennen@scmontafon.at before the first TC meeting starts. At this point the test result must not be older than 58 hours.
- Daily complete the registration and health questionnaire. If you experience any symptoms of illness, please report your medical condition to the OC and stay out of the competition area, in order to prevent a possible Covid spread.
- Always wear FFP2 masks in the entire event area, indoors, outdoors, when riding on the cable car and on private and public means of transportation. Athletes can only remove the mask within the starting area.
- Keep a minimum distance of two meters from other people.
- · Inspection staggered in small groups according to the daily race program.
- · Wash and disinfect your hands frequently.
- It is highly recommended to download the national contact tracing app "Stopp Corona".

Valid medical certificates and test results

The test result or the medical certificate must be submitted in German or English and must contain at least the following data:

- · Surname and forename of the tested person
- Date of birth
- Date and time of the test
- Test result with stamp of the doctor or institution

Local COVID-Test Option:

The "Montafoner Testzentrum "is located in Schruns and is supported by the state of Vorarlberg in cooperation with the Austrian Red Cross. There is a free possibility to carry out a rapid antigen test, in which the result is sent via SMS after about one hour. A Pre-registration is mandatory – online: worarlberg.at/coronatest or by phone on 0810 810 600. (Adress: Kulturbühne Schruns, Batloggstraße 24, 6780 Schruns). We recommend that you register early.

Entry Regulations for Austria in case of Europe Cup Events

If you are entering Austria to compete in an event from "national Interest" (the LOC will provide an invitation letter from the Austrian ministry) you can enter Austria without quarantine of 10 days, if you have the following confirmations with you:

- Letter of confirmation from your NSA that you are a professional athlete / coach / staff
- Invitation letter from the Austrian ministry for your planned competition (provided by the LOC)
- Medical certificate or test result (Antigen or PCR) which confirms that you are negative tested Covid-19 (not older than 72 hours). The test result (in German or English) must include:
 - · Surname and forename of the tested person
 - Date of birth
 - Date and time of the test
 - Test result with stamp of the doctor or institution

Your entry is in the compelling interest of the Republic of Austria and you do not need to do the online-registration through the Pre-Travel-Clearance by exception mentioned in § 7(1) or § 8 of the Covid-19 entry regulation. You are allowed to travel to and from Europe Cup competitions in Austria. In the case of a regulatory review, the facts must be made substantiated by the Invitations letter from the Austrian ministry, the test result and the letter of confirmation from your NSA.

<u>Template medical certificate</u> (A test result issued in Austria or a foreign test result issued in German or English is equated to this certificate)

The entry requirements are at the level of 14 February 2021. Until the race weekend can still always be changes. Please also inform yourself about the regulations for entering the country to which you are going to travel next.
