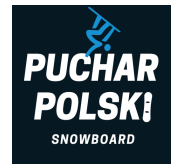

The declaration of an accredited participant of the event

In connection with the participation in the event of FIS Race in Poland, Wisła, on the 19-21st February 2021. In accordance with the recommendations of the Chief Sanitary Inspector during presence of virus Sars-CoV-2 in Poland.

1) Hereby, I solemnly declare that within 14 days prior to making this statement:

- a. I am not infected with the Sars-CoV-2 virus that causes COVID19 disease;
- b. I am not under mandatory quarantine or under epidemiological surveillance;
- c. I do not have symptoms of COVID19 including a fever, a cough, shortness of breath and trouble with breathing.

2) In case I develop coronavirus symptoms in the 14 days after the event, I undertake to immediately inform the competent sanitary-epidemiological authority for the territory of the event and Polish Ski Association at email: office@pzn.pl, and also to take all necessary activities according to Chief Sanitary Inspector guidance:

INFORMATION CLAUSE ON COLLECTING AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN ORDER TO PROVIDE AN ACCREDITATION

FIS Race held in Poland, Krynica, on the 19-21st February 2021.

All data provided in accreditation form shall be processed by Polish Ski Association (ul. Mieszczńska 18/3, 30-313 Kraków) in order to provide accreditation for participants of FIS Races Krynica on the 19-21st February 2021 and also to communicate with accredited participants during the event.

The data administrator is Polish Ski Association. You can contact the administrator in relation to the processing of the personal data at the email address: t.tylka@pzn.pl or write at: Polish Ski Association ul. Mieszczńska 18/3 30-313 Kraków

The data subject has the right: of access to personal data, to be provided with a copy of the personal data, to rectify, delete, limit processing, data transfer to other administrator, object, and to withdraw consent for the processing of their data at any time.

The data subject has the right to file a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if it believes that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.

In order to process accreditation application, the administrator shall be entitled to transfer personal data to services providers. The administrator shall be entitled to process personal data for a period of 2 years starting from the date of giving consent.

Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or international organisation. Polish ski association does not use automatic decision-making nor profiling systems.

Providing data is voluntary. Lack of consent to the processing of personal data makes it impossible to apply for an accreditation.
