#### The declaration of an accredited participant of the event

# INFORMATION CLAUSE ON COLLECTING AND PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN ORDER TO PROVIDE AN ACCREDITATION

FIS Race held in Poland, Krynica, on the 19-21st February 2021.

All data provided in accreditation form shall be processed by Polish Ski Association (ul. Mieszczańska 18/3, 30-313 Kraków) in order to provide accreditation for participants of FIS Races Krynica on the 19-21st February 2021 and also to communicate with accredited participants during the event.

The data administrator is Polish Ski Association. You can contact the administrator in relation to the processing of the personal data at the email address: t.tylka@pzn.pl or write at: Polish Ski Association ul. Mieszczańska 18/3 30-313 Kraków

The data subject has the right: of access to personal data, to be provided with a copy of the personal data, to rectify, delete, limit processing, data transfer to other administrator, object, and to withdraw consent for the processing of their data at any time.

The data subject has the right to file a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if it believes that the processing of personal data violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.

In order to process accreditation application, the administrator shall be entitled to transfer personal data to services providers. The administrator shall be entitled to process personal data for a period of 2 years starting from the date of giving consent.

Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or international organisation. Polish ski association does not use automatic decision-making nor profiling systems.

Providing data is voluntary. Lack of consent to the processing of personal data makes it impossible to apply for an accreditation.
