FOREWORD

DEAR LADIES AND GENTLEMEN ! As Organizers Kitzbühel Ski Club, we ask you for your support during the 82nd Hahnenkamm Races in the second pandemic winter of 2021/22. Observance and compliance with this protocol is prerequisite for official facilitation of the races. THANK YOU – HKR OC.

NOTE: Written details valid for the 82. HKR race week are in the decision-making process and rely on governmental decisions. This protocol is subject to change – also in short term notice.

C19 ORIENTATED ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES FOR THE 2022 RACES:

- The outcome all governmental regulations is, that the Hahnenkamm-Races as a professional sports event can basically take place. The main differentiating factor is the approval of spectators on site.
- With the essential core element of short-term flexibility, the organizer is preparing for the implementation of the pandemic protection regulations applicable in Austria at the time of the race week.
- The Hahnenkamm-Races are an outdoor sport event without any specific body contact. For top athletes, the Covid-19 access regulations for sports facilities apply, for supervisors, coaches, media and other people who are necessary for organising the event, the Covid-19 access regulations apply to the location of the workplace or professional activity (including use of the cable car).

C19 NEGATIVE TEST – DOCUMENTS BEFORE ARRIVAL AND ACCREDITATION

The control of the "G" certificates for all accredited persons is basically carried out by the organizer according to the procedure prescribed by the International Ski Federation FIS. The accreditation is here the document of confirmation. All accredited persons regardless of the "G" status have to present a currently negative PCR test at the beginning of the race week, with the necessity of submitting a repeat test every 48 hours until the end of the race week for all those who have not been vaccinated / recovered [privat1].

- Presentation of a max. 48 h old negative PCR test result on the FIS Passport or per E-Mail covid-19@hahnenkamm.com or to be shown at the Covid Office
- Detailed necessary information must include date and time of when the test was taken
- must include name, address, homepage and email of the testing laboratory
- documented in one of the three FIS recognised languages of German, English or French

To receive the Accreditation Members of the Group OC and Media need to accept the C-19-Confirmation for accredited People. The C19-HKR-Protocol as well as all related regulations of the Austrian government and local health authorities will be attached. The relevant measures and recommendations must be complied with, and instructions from the control staff must be followed.

TEAMS

The pre-event health questionnaire must also be correctly filled out in the Covid-19-FIS-Passport. Only if the aforementioned documents in the FIS passport have been validated, will accreditations be handed over to the Team Captain, or an authorised person in the Race Office. Upload of the PCR test at least 12h before accreditation.

By registering for the event, the team and thus its members registered on the official team entry list confirm and accept the Organizers' C19 Protocols as well as all related regulations of the Austrian government and local health authorities. In particular, they acknowledge the risk of contracting a Covid-19 infection during their stay and the associated substantial effects this may have on their physical health.

C19 FOLLOW UP-TEST

A follow up test on site is required for all people who are not vaccinated/not recovered on every 48h till the end of the Race week. The test result has to be uploaded on FIS passport or send by E-Mail covid-19@hahnenkamm.com or to be shown at the Covid Office. Please inform Organizers Covid-19 Coordinator about the intended technical details of this follow up test by the racing team in time.



C19 TEST – SYMPTOMS ON SITE

Daily self-check on any Covid related symptoms before work. In case of Covid-19 symptoms the person should absolutely not arrive on site.

TEAMS: FIS C19 Protection Regulations require team members to submit a daily health questionnaire before each training and competition. This must be entered in the FIS passport.

- **MOST COMMON SYMPTOMS:** High temperature, dry cough, unusual tiredness, loss of sense of taste or smell
- **CASE-WISE SYMPTOMS:** headache, aching limbs, sore throat, diarrhoea
- **SEVERE SYMPTOMS:** difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, pain or feeling of pressure in the chest area, loss of speech or movement.

If a person feels unwell and shows COVID-19 symptoms on site, contact the organiser's Covid-19 coordinator immediately for an antigen test (mandatory). (+43 664-173 4419). The affected person must go into self-isolation and wear a FFP2 mask. An isolation room is available during the day at the medical operations centre below the Finish Area.

Immediate self isolation must be organised and the person needs to wear a FFP2 mask at all time. Covid Tests and Isolationroom are possible at the Medical Center behind the KSC Villa.

A PCR test with results within 8 hours will be organised. If the test is positive, the information will be passed on to the official health authorities and FIS, based on the various protocols. The respective Team Captain assures his support to the Organizer and the authorities for contact tracing and will provide appropriate lists of names and contacts.

If there is a need for quarantine room please contact the Organizers Hotel Office.

C-19 APPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR ON SITE (see overview in attachment)

CONTACTDATA-COLLECTION: Contact Data of all officially accredited people of the event is saved in the accreditation system. Duplication or Storage of the Proof of G won't happen. The contact data collection is only for the health authority for any possible contact tracing.

CONTACT TRACING Austrian national regulations might confirm persons as contact persons in accordance with the local health authority and is depending on case by case.

In general, stay in small groups within your team/staff and wear FFP-2 Mask to avoid to be a contact person.



Based on current national regulations and requirements of the Organizer, further compulsory behaviour includes:

PROOF OF „G“

- According to the expected situation, it can be assumed that a "G-certificate" is required for the use of cable cars and chair lifts, as well as for access to the event site.

MOUTH AND NOSE PROTECTION

- FFP2 masks are mandatory in public buildings and indoors and outdoor wherever distance of min. 2 Meters cannot be hold. In the event area, the wearing of face masks in the Start, Finish Area and coaches towers is obligatory. It is also compulsory in all gondolas and on chair lifts, including the footpaths between the gondola/lift to the Start Area or from the Finish to the gondola/lift.
- FFP2 are not compulsory on skis during sports.
- Wearing a FFP2 mask is obligatory in the Organizers offices. The OC-team can be separated from other people by a physical barrier / window (aerosol transmission protection).

DISTANCE

- Keep Distance min. 2 Meters to other people.

HYGIENE

- Follow the general hygiene measures (avoid hand contact and hugs, disinfect your hands regularly, observe appropriate etiquette when coughing or sneezing (in the crook of your arm!) and wash or disinfect your hands regularly.
- Avoid areas with high volume / loud noises. Do not speak loudly or shout to avoid increased aerosol particle emissions.
- Take responsibility for self-quarantining if any signs of infection are felt.

ATTENTION: Withdrawal of accreditation in case of willful non-compliance!

ARRIVAL / PARKING

Restrictions on entry to Austria are to be expected, depending on the respective situation during the race week. The HKR race and press office will provide timely information on this. The type of arrival and appropriate infection control behavior upon arrival is the responsibility of the respective person.

Individual arrival and transport shuttle service from the organizer is not offered. Only the allocated and designated parking spaces for the respective groups are to be used (parking cards in the press or race office). The type of approach and appropriate infection protection behavior when approaching are the responsibility of the individual. For the approval to travel from abroad, the travel regulations of the Austrian government applicable at the time must be observed. The organizer will be happy to provide assistance if necessary.



QUARTIER / HOSPITALITY

The national regulations for hotels and restaurants apply. Urgent request for strict observance of the applicable measures.

SKI AREA / CABLE CARS

Please observe the currently prescribed general measures in the ski area, especially when using the cable cars and lifts.

Special information regarding the access regulations for the Hahnenkamm gondola lift (DH) and the Ganslern chair lift (SL) for accredited persons is available from the race office. Concerning the finish area there will be a "G-proof" check for spectators on all training days, as well regarding access to the event area on all race days.

The public slope "Parallel Streif" will be closed to the general public in the morning until the end of the event on race days. During this time, the descent is only possible for accredited persons and skiers with access authorization. After the event (in the afternoon), the Parallel Streif will be open to ski guests. The ski area is expected to be open to public skiing.

MEDIA ZONE ON SITE

Media representatives are given a permanently assigned workstation in the press center. Temporary workplaces can be made available if required. Special regulations apply to the specially designated media zones in the event area (especially the mixed zone); this area will be adapted for contact between TEAMS and MEDIA.

Information will be given to the press office upon arrival. Team captains' meetings are planned online and broadcast on the big screen in the press writing room; a press conference is refrained from.

FREE TIME ACTIVITIES

The organizer does not offer any leisure or public supporting programs to reduce the risk of infection. In principle, all leisure activities are the responsibility of the respective person.

POSSIBLE CHANGES

On the basis of possible updates of the national regulations, requirements of the local health authority and internal guidelines, the organizer reserves the right to make and announce necessary changes at short notice.

1. By signing this form, I confirm receipt of the general guidelines appertaining to the Covid-19 Protective Measures and the Covid-19-HKR-Protocol for my planned working assignment at the 82nd Hahnenkamm Races 2022. By accepting my accreditation, I undertake to strictly adhere with these guidelines.
2. During the last 14 days I had no conscious contact with a person who tested positive for Covid-19 and I have not tested positive for Covid-19 myself in the last 14 days.
3. I hereby certify that I have had no symptoms of a Corona infection in the past 14 days and that I am not currently suffering from any other infectious, flu or cold disease and that I am not aware of any illnesses or symptoms of illnesses in this regard in my household or in my immediate personal or professional environment.
4. Should any such illness or symptoms of illness occur during my participation in the 82nd Hahnenkamm Races 2022 I assure the Organizer that I will immediately enter self-isolation in home quarantine and take the specified further steps according to the Covid-19 Protocol.
5. I acknowledge that persons suffering from a general immune deficiency or lung disease and elderly persons (high risk groups) are generally advised not to participate in the event.
6. I acknowledge that I am at risk of contracting Covid-19 during the course of my work and am aware of the associated massive effects this may have on my physical health.
7. My work for the Hahnenkamm races is subject to Section 11 of the C-19 Protective Measures Ordinance applicable at the time. The required G proof must be carried with you at all times at the place of the professional activity.

- *No mask for skiing.*



HYGIENE

in Armbeuge.
- Räume lüften (stündlich).

HYGIENE

- *Avoid hugs, shaking hands, noisy areas, do not speak loudly.*
- *Wash and disinfect hands regularly, appropriate etiquette when coughing or
sneezing.*
- *Ventilate rooms (every hour).*

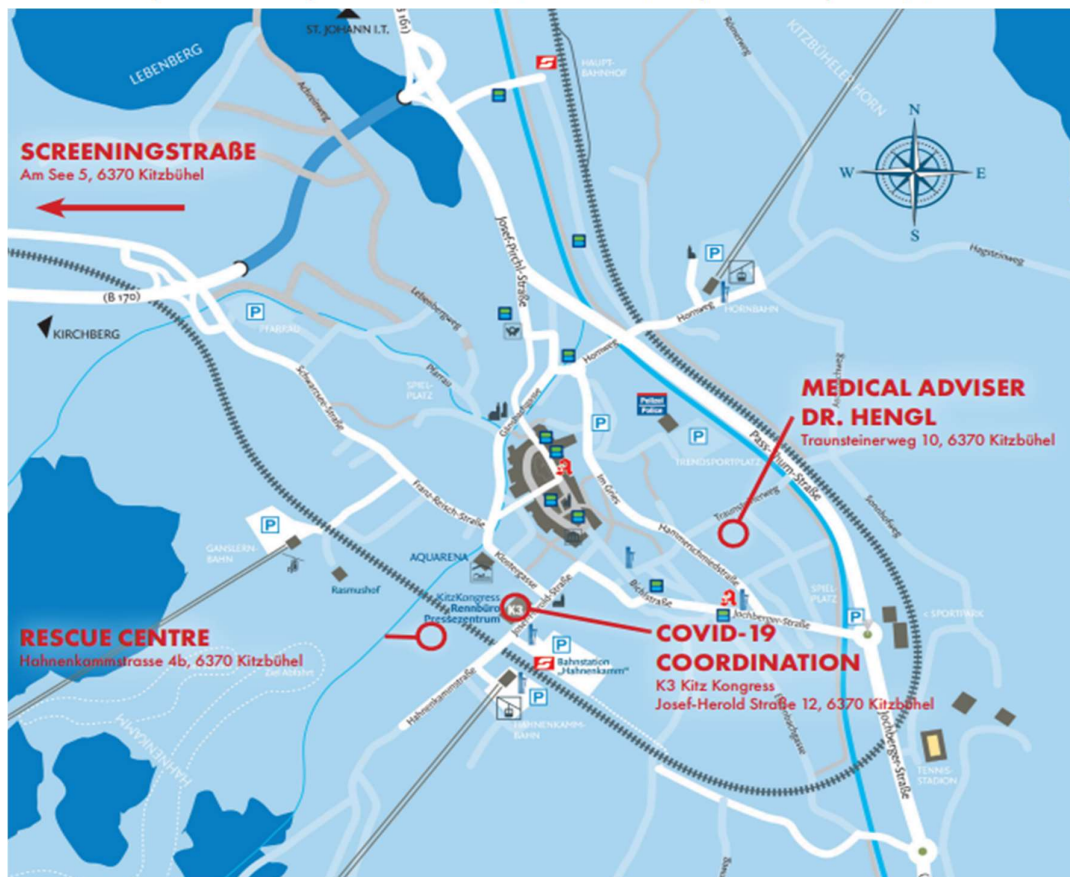
