

COVID-19 risk management for FIS European Cup races in Ahrntal on 15 and 16 December

1 Introduction and contact information

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the FIS European Cup in Ahrntal organized on 15 and 16 December, must take place under tight security measures due to the continuing COVID-19 pandemic. Based on the current national and regional regulations published by the health authorities and further measures taken by FIS and FISI, we would like to present the following catalogue of measures to all teams.

Athletes and team staff must be informed about all the rules and regulations concerning COVID-19 by their team captains.

Protection regulations during the competition (with FIS Passport) 2

2.1 What is required for accreditation

To receive accreditation, each team member must register on the FIS Passport platform and complete the necessary steps, which are (if you are already registered, you can start at point 4):

- Register on https://fispassport.fis-ski.com/fis/ (the access code is FIS2022).
- Complete the registration form and upload your Covid Health Status (vaccinated or recovered).
- Get an e-mail with your TAN Code and click on the link given there
- Login with your TAN Code and select the event (15.12.2021-16.12.2021 Valle Aurina/Ahrntal (ITA) -EC--SL-W)
- Insert date of arrival/departure and click on "save" (see figure below)
- Get an e-mail with the instructions for the health questionnaire (you can fill it out with WhatsApp or webform). These e-mails are sent out once a day, so be patient
- Upload your negative PCR test not older than 72 hours upon accreditation
- Check if both buttons are green

You will only receive accreditations if both buttons on the event page of the FIS Passport are green for all team members.

2.2 Protection regulations for the team captains' meeting

The following protective regulations apply at the team captains' meeting:

- ✓ Only one representative of each team may participate.
- Bring your accreditation (= valid FIS Passport registration).
- Wear a face mask at all times.
- Keep a safety distance of at least 1 meter.
- Wash and disinfect your hands frequently (use the available disinfectant provided).

2.3 Protection regulations for the races

The following protective regulations apply to the whole racing area:

- Bring your accreditation (= valid FIS Passport registration).
- Do not form groups at the entrance or inside.
- Wear a face mask at all times.
- Keep a safety distance of at least 1 meter.
- Wash and disinfect your hands frequently (use the available disinfectant provided).
- There will be a starting corridor that will provide enough space so that the distance rules can be kept. Each athlete can only be accompanied by one staff member into the starting corridor.
- ✓ The athletes are only allowed to take off their mask after entering the starting corridor and must put them on again as soon as possible at the finish.
- The awards and flower ceremony will take place after the races in the finish area in a reduced version and in compliance with the safety regulations.

There are separate entries for athletes/team support staff and the the local organising committee (officials, personnel, workforce, volunteers).



























Local COVID-19 regulations and general recommendations 3

For your stay in Ahrntal during the competition, the local COVID-19 safety regulations will apply. These are as followed:

- It is obligatory to always have a face mask with you and to wear it in closed places.
- Keep a safety distance of at least 1 meter. If this is not possible, also wear the mask outdoors.
- Wash and disinfect your hands frequently.
- When present at the hotel, you must have a 3G-verification (Green pass)
- If you want to have a meal in a restaurant outside the hotel, you need a 2G-verification (Super Green
- To have access to ski lift facilities you need a 3G-verification (Green pass)

Explanation 3G and 2G:

3G: Vaccinated, Recovered, or PCR test not older than 72 hours

2G: Vaccinated, Recovered

To minimise the risk of infection, the LOC makes the following recommendations for your stay during the competition:

- Form small groups.
- Avoid contact with other teams.
- Avoid contact with staff members of the LOC.
- Avoid contact with tourists/fans.
- Wear a face mask (type FFP2) and maintain the minimum distance between during interviews.
- Regularly wash your hands and disinfect.
- Document your health and any changes to your health.

II FIS Passport - TAN CODE and LOG-IN

Q2: I have lost my FIS Passport TAN CODE – what can I do?

A2: If you have lost the TAN CODE, please contact the FIS Covid-19 Support

III FIS Passport - Pre-Event Questionnaire

Q4: I have not received the Pre-Event Questionnaire – what can I do?

A4: The FIS Passport application sends automatically the Pre-Event Questionnaire to all registered participants 6 days prior to the first official training or competition day. A reminder will be sent if the Pre-Event Questionnaire was not answered by the following day. The time for the Pre-Event Questionnaire to be sent to all registered participants is set at 04h CET.


NOTE: If you made a short-notice registration for an event, the Pre-Event questionnaire will be sent to you by the time that registration for the event is made.

IV FIS Passport – Activation Pre-Event and Daily Questionnaire

Q5: How can I activate the Pre-Event or Daily questionnaire received on Whats App

A5: Please proceed with the following steps:


Step 1: You will receive the activation message from FIS Passport to activate the Pre-Event or Daily Questionnaire



Step 2: Activate the Pre-Event or Daily Questionnaire by replying : "Covidpre" or "Covidday"



Step 3: You will receive first Question



V FIS Passport – Upload Covid-19 Test

Q6: I have made two Covid-19 Tests, can I upload them both?

A6: It is possible to upload up to the three Covid-19 TEST certificates per event.



VI FIS Passport – Event Accreditation

Q7: I uploaded all required data/information to the FIS Passport, can I get my accreditation now?

A7: The FIS Passport application do not provide any type of approval for enquiring the event accreditation. The FIS Passport facilitates the database for the Event Covid-19 Health Coordinator to review all uploaded data/information and confirm that all Covid-19 requirements for particular event are fulfilled. The Covid-19 Health Coordinator/department at the LOC will clear the accreditation.

VII FIS Passport – Positive PCR Test

Q8: I previously was infected with Covid-19 (up to 3 months), and my PCR Test is still positive, can I still be cleared for event participation?

A8: The review must be done be the respective LOC. Therefore it is helpful if the certificate on the previous infection is saved for attached in the FIS Passport to the respective event, so the LOC has the information at hand. It is also recommended to communicate directly with the respective LOC Covid-19 Health Coordinator. In some regions only negative PCR Test is accepted as first condition for participation on the event, some will check the "CT value" as a cut-off reference.

Q9: I have been tested positive on Anti-bodies, can I be excluded from the weekly PCR Test?

A9: Please follow up on LOC Covid-19 Health and Test Protocols on the FIS Calendar Page, as not all of the Health Authorities will accept it. PCR Test will be still required.

IX FIS Passport – Info about Covid-19 Vaccine

Q10: Do I need still need to undergo Covid-19 testing if I have already been vaccinated.

Also when you are certified vaccinated (meaning having received both required vaccines and completed the waiting time after the last vaccine), the majority of the LOCs still require Covid-19 testing. A small number has confirmed certified testing will be accepted (refer to LOC testing protocols).
