



FIS Alpine Ski European Cup 2022 Sarntal COVID-19 Guidelines

1. Introduction

We apply the generally valid rules for prevention and managing Covid-19 infection and disease in field of race and in event organisation. The WHO and IOC Medical Department rules are integrated in a local test and safety program directed by Dr. Patrick Franzoni.

Athletes and team staff must be informed by their team captains about this measures and rules concerning COVID-19.

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3. Protection Measures during the event

To manage and control most of the protection measures we use the **FIS Passport** software.

3.1 Requirements for attending the event

Requirements for all team members (athletes and officials):

- valid EU Covid 2G Certificate (EU Green Pass vaccination or recovery certificate)
- negative PCR test not older than 72 h
- valid registration for the FIS Passport and successful application for the event
- daily management of the health questionnaire

3.2 Registering for the FIS Passport and applying to the event

Register for the **FIS Passport** and apply to the EC event. Please do the registration in time. Ideally **2 weeks** before the event.

The essential steps are:

- Registration for the FIS Passport on <u>https://fispassport.fis-ski.com/fis/</u> <u>Access code is: FIS2022</u>
- Provide personal data and upload the EU 2G Green Pass (vaccinated or recovered)
- Apply to the European Cup event in Sarntal
- Manage Event Application
 For the use of the event application you will receive an e-mail with the link to the application and the personal TAN Code for the access.
- Click on the link in the e-mail, login with your personal TAN, select the European Cup event in Sarntal, enter arrival and departure date and save the inputs
- For the management of the health questionnaire, you will receive e-mails from the event application.
 Fill out the questionnaire by WhatsApp or web form.
 These e-mails are sent out from the system once a day, so be patient.
- Upload your negative PCR test not older than 72 hours upon accreditation
- Check both status indicators, the one for "Covid-19 Pre-Event Test Results" and the one for "Pre-Event Health Questionnaire". Only if both indicators are green, the registration for the event is successful.

Team members will receive accreditations only, if both buttons are green, on the event page of the FIS Passport.

3.3 Regulations for the team captains' meeting

- only one representative per team can participate
- all participants need a valid accreditation (bracelet)
- wearing a FFP2 mask is compulsory
- safety distance of at least 1 meter

3.4 Regulations for the races

- the race area is closed for spectators
- only athletes and officials with a valid accreditation bracelet will have access
- wearing a FFP2 mask is compulsory in all event areas
- Masks don't need to be worn in the following exceptional circumstances: athletes in the warming-up areas and in the start corridor
- safety distance of at least 1 meter in all areas
- each athlete can be accompanied by only one staff member
- the prize giving ceremony will take place immediately after the race in the finish area in a reduced version and in compliance with the safety regulations

3.5 Regulations for FIS Delegates, Timing and Data Service staff

Everyone who belongs to this group needs:

- a 2G Green Pass (vaccination or recovering from Covid 19 in the last 180 days certification)
- a PCR Test not older than 72 hours
- wear a FFP2 mask

3.6 Regulations for LOC members, Media, Journalists

All persons in near contact with the athletes and/or Team members need:

- a 2G Green Pass (vaccination or recovering from Covid 19 in the last 180 days certification)
- a PCR Test not older than 72 hours
- wear a FFP2 mask masks can be taken off while sitting at your desk

















3.7 Regulations for slope rescue team

Members of this team need:

- a 2G Green Pass (vaccination or recovering from Covid 19 certification)
- wear a FFP2 mask

3.8 Regulations for Volunteers, Guests, Suppliers

Everyone who belongs to this group needs:

- a 2G Green Pass (vaccination or recovering from Covid 19 certification)
- wear an FFP2 mask

3.9 Reporting of sickness during the event

If you have any cold symptoms (cough, runny nose, sore throat, difficult breathing, loss of taste or smell) or in case of feeling sick, please follow these proceedings:

- Report to the team captain - Go into self isolation at the hotel

Follow the instractions given by the LOC Covid Manager

- Rapid Test will be conducted
- Isolation until the result
- In case of positive rapid test, further measures and tests will be coordinated by FIS and local health authorities

















4. Accreditation

4.1 Accreditation for athletes and team members

Wednesday, 02.02.2022 in the race office from 16:00 to 18:45.

The race office is located at the valley station of the Gondola Lift in Reinswald. Only one representative per team can pick up accreditations for the whole team.

With a valid FIS Passport and EC event registration, you become the accreditation in form of a bracelet. Registration control by the LOC on the FIS Passport LOC Portal.

4.2 Accreditation for all other people involved in the event

Individual accreditation every day at the first access to the event area.

5. Local COVID-19 Regulations and Recommendations

5.1 General Regulations

Transportation and Lift facilities

- the capacity is limited to 80% of the normal conveying capacity
- Covid 2G Certificate (vaccination or recovery certificate) is required
- wearing a FFP2 mask is compulsory

Gastronomy (bars and restaurants)

- indoor consumption is only permitted with the 2G Covid Certificate
- both, customers and staff, must wear a FFP2 mask

Accommodation establishments

• for the access to the Hotel, to indoor swimming pools, wellness and thermal facilities, gyms and fitness centres, the 2G Covid Certificate is required



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5.2 General Recommendations

- FFP2 mask recommended in all closed places
- Change masks frequently
- Safety distance of at least 1 meter. If this is not possible also wear a mask outside.
- recommended basic precautions: handwashing, respiratory hygiene, distancing responsible, daily health self-assessment, avoid hand shaking, availability of contact details for rapid contact tracing
- limit direct contacts and be responsible
