For starter eligibility, we proceed according to the official FIS-quota-rules. This will be announced at the online team captains meeting. We will collect a entry fee of € 20,00 in cash per runners and race from the foreign associations at the COVID-Checkpoint in front of the lift entrance Starjet1. The lift Starjet1 opens on Saturday and Sunday at 7am. You will also get the lift-tickets & bibs there.

COVID-19 Prevention Guidelines and Recommendations for teams:

"2,5 G" COVID-19 status confirmation is mandatory for all team members (athletes, coaches, staff, NSA officials etc.)



#### WHAT IS IMPORTANT

Taking personal responsibility:

- Hygiene measures (regular hand washing, regular disinfection)
- Maintain a minimum distance of 1 meter in all areas (social distancing)
- FFP 2 masks are mandatory for all lift transport and inside buildings
- For all transports in buses / cars masks are mandatory and maximum occupancy with 2 athletes per row
- In case of Covid-19 symptoms prior the event, do not attend
- Avoid direct contact with other teams
- Avoid direct contact with LOC staff
- A maximum of 3 people from a team may ride the chairlift and wearing a FFP 2 mask is mandatory
- Take your Covid-19 status confirmation (2,5G) with you it has to be presented by Hotels / Ski resorts
- Professional athletes need a confirmation by their National Ski Association that they are "professional athletes"

We appeal to EVERYONE to take their OWN RESPONSIBILITY and to comply and implement all measurements and recommendations made! Guidelines are used to implement or control compliance with the COVID-19 specifications. For your own safety and the safety of other people, you must follow the instructions of the operational staff

### COVID Hotline during the event +43 6457 3073-20

- In case of a team member not feeling well or showing COVID-19 symptoms, please inform the LOC immediately by calling the COVID Hotline.
- This number can be reached 24 hours from the 17th to the 19th of december 2022.
- The LOC will employ measures set out to deal with suspected cases of COVID-19.
- There is an isolation room provided near the venue in case you show symptoms.
- Any communication related to COVID-19 has to be coordinated with LOC.
- COVID-19 suspected case management: If there is a suspected case of COVID-19, please contact the COVID Hotline +43 6457 3073-20. A standby service is available on site, which regulates the further procedures (isolating, testing) with isolation and contact with the authorities. In case of a positive test result, the authorities will decide on possible quarantine of further people in the surroundings (e.g., team members). Isolation is imposed exclusively by the responsible health authority.
