SSNZ SLOPESTYLE SERIES POINTS & RANKINGS

FIS & WSPL

Athletes who are eligible and currently hold a FIS license may be included in the FIS result however having a FIS license is not mandatory to be able to enter this event. New Zealand athletes with a FIS license will automatically be included in the FIS result unless they opt out. International FIS entries must send the official FIS entry form to luke@snowsports.co.nz and register through the SSNZ website.

AGE DIVISIONS

Ski/Snowboard & Boys/Girls

U14 (Born 2008, or younger)

Open (all ages) *All competitors will compete together in this event and results split afterward.

FORMAT

Showdown Format: 2 Run Slopestyle. Top 25% are given a 3rd run which can only better the current score.

ENTRY & LIFT PASSES

Entry is \$35 and completed through the Snow Sports NZ website. Competitors are encouraged to pre-register online and avoid the extra \$10 added to the On the Day (OTD) entries. OTD entry is completed at the Slope-side Guest service ticket office located on the slope side of the archway (Not the main ticket office) The discounted child's lift pass is \$55 and an adult lift pass is \$105. Event Parent passes are available by request on the day.

BIB ALLOCATION

Competitor bibs can be collected from 7.30 - 8.30am on the competition day at the events desk in the Slopeside Ticket office on mountain.
