The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.

This competition is a Ski Cross event and is open to both men and women

This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants

The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, or by the decision of the competition jury.

7. BIBS AND HELMETS

It is mandatory for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A penalty will be charged to every competitor who does not wear his/her bib.

8. LIABILITY

All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organising Committee, Reiteralm, the Austrian Ski Federation, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries occurred or suffered by competitors, officials or any other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.



























9. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee, Reiteralm, the FIS and the Austrian Ski Federation will not be held responsible for accidents and, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

10. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital.

























IMPORTANT COVID 19 RULES

The FFP2 mask requirement applies in the Start- and Finisharea, in all closed rooms, public transport, in the queuing areas, on the lifts, in the gondolas and outdoors wherever the minimum distance of 2 meters cannot be maintained.

The races will be closed to spectators - just participating athletes and responsible team coaches are allowed to stay at the event facilities.

All athletes and coaches must complete the registration and health questionnaire daily. - FIS Passport

Due to the high corona numbers and to protect the teams at the Crosspark, Crosspark Reiteralm and the Austrian Ski Federation require all athletes and supervisors who are at the Crosspark for the EC and FIS Races to provide proof of negative PCR Test. Regardless if vaccinated or not.

<u>UPLOAD YOUR PCR Test to</u> the FIS-Passport

Negative PCR test upon arrival (not older than 48 hours) then a negative PCR test that is not older than 48 hours must be continuously uploaded to the FIS Passport - Antigen Test will not be accepted
