Ski Sport Finland is pleased to invite all the teams to attend the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Opening in Aerials, on December 2.-3. 2021, and in Moguls, on December 4th 2021, in Ruka Ski Resort, Finland.

The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition Rules (ICR) of the International Ski Federation (FIS). All National ski Associations affiliated with FIS are invited to compete.

2. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

Access to the online registration system is possible through the FIS Homepage http://www.fis-ski.com / Member Section.

All quotas and entries are according to the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Rules 2021/2022. Only those competitors who are entered by National Associations are eligible and the number of participants is limited under current World Cup quotas.

Provisional Entries:

Saturday 23. October 2021

Each National Association must inform the Organizers about the expected total number of team members (Names, FIS Codes and Gender, team officials) arrival and departure dates. This needs to be done using the "Competition Online Entry System".

Final Entries:

Monday 22. November 2021

No later than 10 days before the competition day the NSA must inform the OC of its final entries (Names, FIS Code and Gender) with their arrival and departure dates. Teams or persons who register after the deadline will not be eligible for FIS rates.

3. COVID-19 PREVENTIVE MEASURES

The FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup opening will take place with enhanced safety measures.

The OC will follow all guidelines from FIS and the Finnish government. Travel to Finland is possible by following the instructions set by the Finnish Boarder Guard, link:

4. REGISTRATION

Check-in, team registration, race headquarters, and team captains' meetings will all be done safely, preventing physical contacts, mainly online.

4. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition, and award ceremonies.

5. PRIZE MONEY

The total amount of prize money for Aerials is CHF 100'000 and for Moguls CHF 50'000. The prize money breakdown is in accordance with the FIS rules and all money transfers will be made electronically within 7 business days after the event.

In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to review and doublecheck the bank account information for each athlete at the FIS Member Section.

The prize money is divided with the events as follows:

AE on 2.12. total CHF 50'000 AE on 3.12. Single Jump, total CHF 25'000 AE on 3.12. Team, total CHF 25'000 MO on 4.12. total CHF 50'000
