### 4. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. Bibs will be given after the full entry fee payment and the time will be announced in the team captain meeting.

Fee for lost/not returned bib is 30 €.

### 5. ENTRY FEE MOGULS EC

Entry fee: CHF 80 per athlete (77 Euros) per competition incl. lift ticket for the venue lift in the Mogul Valley.

Training days: 20 CHF (19 Euros) per athlete incl. lift ticket for the venue lift.

Or in the venue by credit card. Because of Covid-19, no cash is accepted.

### 6. PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be awarded according to the FIS rule.

### 7. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Each competitor must carry his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, City of Jyväskylä, Laajavuori Ski Resort, FIS, Ski Sport Finland nor Jyväskylä Freestyle Club assume no responsibility for accidents, damage or loss of equipment, and second and third party claims during the event.

## COVID-19

To ensure the health and safety for everyone, the OC is working in accordance with the National Health regulations as well as with FIS, in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines.

To receive competition accreditation all 16 years old or older will need a valid Covid passport. That means you need to be fully vaccinated (approved vaccines in Finland: Comirnaty/Pfizer-BionTech, Spikevax/Moderna Biotech, Vaxzevria/AstraZeneca, Janssen/Janssen-Cilag, BIBP, Sinopharm/Beijing Inst. of biological Prod., Covishield/Serum institute of India, CoronaVac/Sinovac life sciences, Covaxin, Bharat Biotech int.) or have a negative Covid-19 test no older than 72 hours or a certificate of having had the Covid-19 virus less than 6 months prior accreditation.

There will be more information about the necessary precautions due to the pandemic available about two weeks before the competition.

All competitors must have their own medical insurance (ICR art 212) which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment expenses.
