Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations with the FIS quotas and rules. The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the name of participants must be submitted to the Organizing Committee no later than 24.1.2022. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies. Fee for lost/not returned bib is 30 €.

ENTRY FEE

CHF 80 (=76 €) / competition incl. lift ticket.

CHF 20 (=19 €) / competitor, training fee on Monday 31.1. and Tuesday 1.2.

You can pay by cash or with a credit card. It is also possible to pay in advance. Contact OC to get the bank details.

PRIZE MONEY

According to the FIS rule, prize money will be awarded.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Each competitor must carry his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, Taivalvaara Ski Resort, FIS, Ski Sport Finland and Taivalkosken Kuohu Freestyle Club assume no responsibility for accidents, damage or loss of equipments, and second and third party claims during the event.

COVID-19

To ensure the health and safety for everyone, the OC is working in accordance with the National Health regulations as well as with FIS, in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines.

To receive competition accreditation all 16 years old or older will need a valid Covid passport. That means you need to be fully vaccinated (approved vaccines in Finland: Comirnaty/Pfizer-BionTech, Spikevax/Moderna Biotech, Vaxzevria/AstraZeneca, Janssen/Janssen-Cilag, BIBP,SInopharm/Beijing Inst. of biological Prod., Covishield/Serum institute of India, CoronaVac/Sinovac life scienses, Covaxin, Bharat Biotech int.) or have a negative Covid-19 test no older than 72 hours or a certificate of having had the Covid-19 virus less than 6 months prior accreditation.

There will be more information about the necessary precautions due to the pandemic available about two weeks before the competition.

All competitors must have their own medical insurance (ICR art 212) which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment expenses.
