- The French freestyle Association and les Arcs Committee are organising an international Europa Cup Freeski competition, part of the 2022 FIS Freeski Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for free skiing.
- This competition is a **Big Air Event** for both men and women
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The organizing committee reserve the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather or the decision of the competition jury

### 4. Registration and means of payment

Organizing Centre:

The organizing centre is located in: La Coupole Arcs 1600 (under the chairlift "Cachette")

Team registration will take place on January Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> from 11:00 to 17:00

All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration in Euros and be paid in cash or Credit Card. Cheques and travellers cheques will not be accepted.

Price: 30 € for the unofficial training

80 € / athlete for the competition

(included ticket and individual meal for Thursday and Friday)

Please collect all bib numbers and all riders and coaches/staff tickets for the whole nation by one team manager. At the pickup, the team manager must provide the accommodation details of the team and confirm compliance with all Covid19 protective measures with a signature.

### 5. Covid 19 Restrictions in France

The Organizing Committee will check the local Covid 19 restrictions on a daily basis. We will contact you in case any issues occur that might put the health of your team and the event in danger.

- All athletes and coaches must :
  - Provide European Agreed Vaccination
  - Or provide PCR Test less than 24h00
  - Or provide a certificate of healing (recovery of Covid between 14 days and 6 month)
- Dailly Check of all kind of certificates.
- European Sanitary Pass (with QR code) is mandatory to go to every Bars/restaurants in France.
- Face masks need to be worn in any closed rooms such as Hotels, Restaurants, Shops and also in the Gondola and Ski Lifts
- Maintain the distance of 1,5 meters in the waiting lines, etc. . .
- If any symptoms may occur, stay at home

For the safety and health of team and OC members, the event will be organized following the strict combined FIS Covid 19 protocol.

## 8) Bibs and Helmets

It is necessary for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets through official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A sanction will be given to any competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will be asked to deposit 10 € per bib. Amount will be refunded by the end of the competitions when bibs are returned.

## 9) Liability

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, les Arcs , the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by nay athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event. All participant are urged no to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

## 10) Accident Insurance & Protocol

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, les Arcs, the FIS and the French Ski Association declines any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.
