GENERAL INFORMATION

2022 FIS Freeski World Cup Tour – Slopestyle Font-Romeu Pyrénées 2000 January 12-16, 2022

Font-Romeu Pyrénées 2000 Resort and the French Ski Federation (FFS) are pleased to invite all Freeski Nations to attend the FIS World Cup Slopestyle event at Font-Romeu Pyrénées 2000 as part of the 2022 FIS Freeski World Cup. The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition rules of the FIS. All national associations affiliated with the FIS are invited to compete.

2. ENTRIES

Preliminary entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit your preliminary entries with the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by Monday, November 15th, 2021.

In agreement with the FIS, your **Final Entries** (final names of your competition participants including competitors and officials) must be received by organizer **no later** than Tuesday, January 4th, 2022.

The online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage www.fis-ski.com - Members Section

FIS has established Quotas rule for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Freeski Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations.

According to FIS rule, please submit your entry before the "provisional entry deadline" on 15th November 2021. Any entries received after this deadline will not be considered.







All participants must have a minimum of 25 FIS Slopestyle points to compete. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the Registration Area for check-in before proceeding to the Slopestyle competition venue. All fees will be collected upon check-in.

Participation Fee: 120 CHF

3. REGISTRATION

Team registration will take place at the Race Office, which will be located at:

Team registration/lodging check-in will take place daily beginning on January 11 2022 – 01.11.2022, from 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

To be eligible for participation in the 2022 FIS Freeski World Cup each competitor must be a citizen of a country from the National Ski Association, with a current FIS license and prove this with a valid passport.

4. ACCOMMODATIONS

The organizing committee can offer reduced prices for accommodation and halfboarding options (50EU to 90EU) depending on accommodation standard. Try booking your lodging as soon as possible. We cannot guarantee a good price accommodation for late bookers. First come, first served.

Important:

- -Team Captains will pay the Rate for the accommodation and meal program upon arrival at the race office.
- -Teams must confirm entries by name and rooming lists for accommodation no later than November 15, 2021.







- -Last minute cancellations or changes to the confirmed rooming list will not be tolerated. At registration, Team Captains will be charged in full (100%) for the dates and number of athletes and officials submitted on the official final entry form / team size form as of January 04, 2022.
- -Teams will be responsible for any additional cost incurred by the Organizing Committee as a result of changes made after January 04, 2022. Refunds will not be paid to teams for rooms released or not occupied by the teams after that date.
- -All additional charges to the rooms are the responsibility of the Team Captain. No additional charges will be made to or accepted by the Organizing Committee.

At the time of check-in at the accommodation, a fully refundable damage deposit; payable on any major credit card of €200 EU will be required for each room. Each National Association (Team) will be held responsible for any damage incurred during its stay.

5. TRANSPORTATION

Teams will be responsible for their own transportation to and from Font Romeu-Pyrénées 2000 Resort.

6. ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each gender.

7. LIABILITY

All Athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing committee, Font-Romeu Pyrénées 2000, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible to any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants are urgent not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.







8. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must be medically insured on her/his own. The Organizing Committee, Font-Romeu Pyrénées 2000, the FIS and the French Ski Association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

9. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of accidents on course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital.

10. SKI STORAGE

The competitors, coaches and officials must store their skis and grooming equipment, as well as wax their skis in the area provided. Skis will not be allowed in your chalet or residence room.

11. BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all official training, competition and award ceremonies.

12. PRIZE MONEY

Note: The cash prize will be transferred to the athletes' account. A withholding tax will be withheld in accordance with French income tax law.

All prize money will be issued following the new FIS prize money process. NSAs must manage all information required for prize money using the FIS Athlete Registration module in the FIS member section. All bank information MUST be uploaded to the FIS database prior to Finals. Athletes without the correct bank information uploaded to the FIS system will experience a delay in prize money bank transfer.

The winners will receive prize money via bank transfer only (no checks).

Men & Women's FIS World Cup Freeski event. 25,000 CHF will be awarded per gender, for each event. Prize money will be awarded to the top 10 men and top 10 women.
