The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the competition rules of the International Ski Federation (FIS) and the World Cup Rules 2021/2022. All national Ski Associations affiliated with FIS are invited to compete.

In order to help you plan your stay we have enclosed some information regarding the event and contact information in case of questions.

Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. The online registration system is accessed on the FIS Homepage in the Member Section

All quotas and entries are according to the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Rules 2021/2022. Only competitors registered by National Ski Associations are eligible and the number of participants is limited under current World Cup quotas.

Freestyle FIS Ski World Cup Final Eligibility Formula and Final Format (WC Rule 3.9.2 to 3.9.4) with limited fields, based on the World Cup Standings after the competition on 9th March 2022 for MO and 12th March 2022 for DM.

This competition is by invitation only (WC rules 2021-2022). The fields are limited to the following maximum numbers Ladies/Men: 30/30 + COC Winners + WJC Winners Competitors

Preliminary registrations: Saturday, February 7, 2022

Each National Ski Associations must inform the organizers of expected total number of team members (names, FIS code and gender, team officials), arrival and departure dates and room requirements (competitors, coaches, accompanying persons and service staff).

This must be done using the "Online Competition Entry System" and respecting the deadlines set and announced by the OC (40 days before the first day of competition).

Confirmation of final registrations: Tuesday, March 8, 2022 for MO and DM.

At the latest 10 days before the day of competition, the NSA must inform the OC of its final registrations (names, FIS code and gender) with their arrival and departure dates. The NSA must also inform the OC of the arrival and departure dates of the official's team.

Note: For any modification after the deadline, the OC may invoice the costs incurred by the cancellation of the accommodation to the NSA concerned. Teams or individuals who register after the deadline will not eligible for FIS rates.

Accommodation and meals

Teams will be lodged in hotel with half board, from Tuesday night March 15th to Sunday morning March 20th, 2022.

50CHF (FIS rate) per person and per day paid to the OC.

Lunch will be organized by the organizing committee

in the tent at the bottom of the course on Cote 2000, 15 € per person.

Each coach has to pay his team accommodation expenses directly to the Organizing Committee the day of his arrival (credit cards only). No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors.

These conditions will be applied to the members registered using the online entry system. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. Teams wishing to arrive before March 15th, 2022, should contact Megève OC.



























COVID-19 preventive measures and health pass

The FIS Moguls & Dual Moguls World Cup Final from March, 15 - 20, 2022 will take place with enhanced safety measures.

The OC will follow all guidelines from FIS and the French government.

The OC reserves right for necessary changes which will be announced immediately.

A few weeks before the event the French sports ministry will provide a letter of compelling reason for the Megeve Ski World Cup so that the teams can clear customs, "pressing ground for travel in France".

Rules

The French ski Federation and Megève Committee are organising an international World Cup Freestyle competition, part of the 2022 FIS Freestyle World cup circuit.

The dates for the competition have been published in the international FIS calendar.

The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulation for Freestyle skiing.

The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.

The organizing committee and the French Ski Federation along with the jury reserve the right

to change the schedule and the place of the event stated in the programme, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the of the competition jury.

Accreditation

All officials and competitors will receive an accreditation card from the Organizing Committee providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn all the time

Bibs

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official training and competition.

Accidents insurance

All competitors must have their own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee declines all liability for any accident or equipment damaged, second and third party claims during trainings and competitions.

Medical Plan and Anti-doping control

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel and ski patrol from the organizing committee will be responsible for any medical decision and evacuation to the hospital or medical center.

























Prize money and Prize Money taxes

Note: The cash prize will be transferred to the athletes' account. A withholding tax will be withheld in accordance with French income tax law.

All prize money will be issued following the new FIS prize money process. NSAs must manage all information required for prize money using the FIS Athlete Registration module in the FIS member section. All bank information MUST be uploaded to the FIS database prior to Finals. Athletes without the correct bank information uploaded to the FIS system will experience a delay in prize money bank transfer.

The winners will receive prize money via bank transfer only (no checks).

Men & Women's FIS World Cup Moguls and Dual Moguls event. 25,000 CHF will be awarded per gender, for each event. Prize money will be awarded to the top 10 men and top 10 women.
