2. RULES

FIS rules will be applied to this competition:

- Georgian Ski Federation , Mountain Trails Agency and the organizing committee of the FIS Freeski World Cup – Slopestyle are organizing the FIS Freeski Slopestyle World Cup on March 1st and 5th; in Bakuriani ski resort, “Didveli” Mountain.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations of Freeski.
- This competition is a Freeski Slopestyle event and is open to both Men and Women.
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on the snow conditions, weather after confirmation of the competition jury.

3. ENTRIES

REGISTRATION/ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page: <http://www.fis-ski.com/> "**Member Section**". FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. DEADLINES FOR TEAM ENTRIES:

Provisional entry deadline January 2nd, 2022 (with names of athletes attending)

Final entry deadline February 21st, 2022.

Competitors entered into FIS Freeski World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Pipe & park points in one of the valid FIS points list. The minimum FIS point requirements per FIS Freeski Park & Pipe World Cup event are:

Minimum Standards to participate in a WC

- 25 FIS points in Slopestyle

Registration and means of Payment

- Registration will take place at race office – located in Hotel “Crystal ” starting Monday 28th February , from 12.00 to 20.00 everyday before the first Team Captain's meeting, February 28th
- Accommodation with Half Board for the dates: 28th February-5th March 2022, is CHF 80 per person per night.

“No Shows” will be charged to the National Associations by LLC “TRIFECTA.”

Important information: To accommodate all athletes, coaches and officials in a correct way, we do need your updated Preliminary Team Entries as soon as possible, January 2nd 2022, the latest. After the above mentioned Deadline for Team Entries the FIS rate for hotel accommodation can't be guaranteed anymore.

Please take into notice that only after paying the accommodation fee, teams will be able to get the accreditation.

PARTICIPATION FEE

According to the FIS Park & Pipe World Cup Rules (art 2.2.4) a mandatory Participation Fee for all entered competitors of CHF 30 per official training, qualification and competition day, total CHF 120 has to be paid to the organizing committee.

Payment

The Participation Fee has to be paid at the Race Office by credit card before the first Team Captains' meeting.

4. BIBS

All competitors must wear their bibs during the official training, competition, and awards ceremony after the competition.

A deposit of CHF 20- per bib will be required in cash at the first team captains' meeting.

5. PRIZE MONEY

6. TRANSFER

- Participants are responsible for their own transportation fee. Bakuriani ski resort is located 190 km away from Tbilisi international airport, The OC offers transfers between the airport of Tbilisi and the resort (busses, mini vans for teams and trucks for equipment). 1. Arrival/departure date, time, flight numbers, destination (from/to)
2. Amount of passengers and all names of participants in a group
3. Amount of luggage in pieces and its approximate total weight.

- Transportation on site will be provided by the OC and will be free of charge.
- The accommodation and transfer request should be sent no later than 12th of February 2022
- Competitors, coaches and OC key staff will be accommodated in Hotel "Crystal"
