







PROTECTIVE MEASURES ON THE STUBAI GLACIER

Current information

Status: 24.03.2022

According to the current COVID measures ordinance of the Austrian federal government, the regulations for cable cars are as follows from 24th march 2022:

- ++ FFP2 masks are compulsory in enclosed means of transport and enclosed spaces (e.g. in the queuing area).
- ++ Abolition of 3G entry controls on cable cars and in restaurants.
