GENERAL RULES

COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL

The AUDI FIS Ski Cross World Cup in San Candindo / 3 Zinnen Dolomites will be held from 19 to 21 December 2021 under increased safety measures.

BASICS / GENARAL RULES OF CONDUCT

- It is the responsibility of every person to adhere to this policy
- Respect hygiene measures
- Wash hands regularly and thoroughly
- Regular and correct use of provided disinfectant dispensers
- It is obligatory to wear a FFP2 or surgical mask in ALL areas (in closed rooms, in shuttle buses, in the cable cars, on chair lifts, in all public places)
- Cover your mouth and nose with your bent elbow when sneezing or coughing
- A minimum distance of 1,5 m with mask applies everwhere
- Avoid shaking hands
- Avoid personal contacts or limit them to a absolute minimum. This also applies to the time outside the event area!
- Avoid contact with people who do not belong to your grouß (RED/BLUE/GREEN) as much as possible
- Check your own health situation daily (if you feel ill and suffer from symptoms such as
 fever, flu symptoms or other symptoms like described in the following chart, stay in your
 room an call the SOS COVID-19 HOTLINE +39 392 18 21 162. In this case the protocol of
 the South Tyrolean Sanitary Service applies and an environment analysis is carried out

Daily Health Questionnaire (optional)

Do you have a fever of 38.0 degree Celsius or higher?

Are you coughing more than usual, especially dry cough?

Do you have shortness of breath?

Do you have loss of teste and/or smell, stuffy nose, unusual aches, abnormal fatigue, unusual headache, or nausea/vomiting and diarrhea?

Have you tested positive to the PCR (Polymerase chain reaction) test during the last 14 days?

It appeals to ALL individual(s) to act responsibly and to adhere to all safety measures and recommendations. Our stewards are required to monitor the implementation of the COVID-19 guidelines. For your own safety and the safety of all other people present, it is essential that your follow the instructions of the stewards. We reserve the right to exclude persons from the event and take legal action against those who do not comply with the COVID-19 guidelines. The organizer also reserves the right to make any necessary changes to the regulations, which will be communicated immediately.





JOURNEY TO SAN CANDIDO / 3 ZINNEN DOLOMITES

- Do not travel to the event location if you show any COVID-19 symptoms
- If persons close to you or people in your environment are ill with COVID-19, pleas call the SOS COVID-19 HOTLINE +39 392 18 21 162
- Avoid stop-overs on your way to the venue
- Avoid personal contact with other people

ACCREDITATION

Due to the current situation, we as organizers must limit the number of accredited persons; pleas only accredit people who are really working during the World Cup races.

The security plan provides that only the following persons should be granted access (accreditation) to the event. All attending persons are divided into Groups (colors).



In addition to the accreditation, each person will receive an identification bracelet in the color of the group (for red and blue group) to which the individual belongs.

Furthermore, in addition to the PCR test uploaded on the FIS Passport, the FIS COVID-19 World Cup Risk Management and Testing Protocol Rules requires all non-vaccinated o non prev. infected persons to undergo one more rapid test every 48h.



Attention: the PCR test must be uploaded on the FIS PASSPORT not more than 72h before arrival in San Candido / 3 Zinnen Dolomites.

The COVID-19 test center is located at the Finsih Area.

Each person who needs to undergo a PCR/rapid test must book for the test in advance writing on the following e-mail: gabriel@innichen.it

The result of the rapid test is announced within 15 – 30 minutes, the PCR test within 12 hours.

SUGGESTIONS FOR LEISURE ACTIVITIES DURING YOUR STAY IN SAN CANDIDO / 3 ZINNEN DOLOMITES

- During all recreational activities, follow COVID-19 safety and hygiene rules such as keeping your distance, wearing a mounth-nose guard, and avoiding personal contact
- Limit your leisure activities to the most necessary purchases and errands
- Spend your free time exclusively with members of your team or group
- To keep the risk of infection as low as possible, the Organizing Committee recommends:
 - Staying only in small groups
 - Avoiding contact with the teams
 - Restricting contact with other people





- Avoiding contact with tourists/fans
- o Keeping your distance, washing your hands frequently or disinfecting them often

TEAMS AND EQUIPMENT PARTNERS

TEAM HOTEL

- Check-in procedure must be carried out with mouth-and-nose protection and the minimum distance must be observed
- If possible, beds in a double room should be separated
- We suggest that dinner for the athletes & co. should be served in a separate room or ahead of residing hotel guests (e.g., already at 7 pm)
- The hotel must guarantee that the athletes have as little contact as possible with the other hotel guests

RACE OFFICE & TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING

- The Race Office is located in the "Casa Josef Resch Haus", Via Atto 2, 39038 San Candido
- The Team Captains' Meeting will be held in the race office and accreditations for the RED group will be handed out in a separate room
- Team Captains'Meeting:
 - With limited number of participants (1 representative per team)
 - o Minimum distance between the chairs
 - Wearing masks (FFP2) is obligatory
- Accreditation Office:
 - Accreditations for RED group can be picked up in the Race Office (Casa Josef Resch Haus)

EVENT AREA

- Obligation to wear FFP2 mask
- It is the responsibility of every person to adhere to this policy
- Observe distancing rules
- Pay attention when entering the different areas: Color of the accreditation shows where the person has access
- Stay exclusively in the zones designated to your accreditation group
- The different zones are closed and only accessible to accredited persons
- Avoid direct contact with the teams and wear a mouth and nose protector

TRAINING

• We offer the possibility to all Teams to train on the Untertal slope. (15. – 20.12.2021)





CHAIR LIFT BARANCI / HAUNOLD

- Separate entrance for athletes / coaches (group RED)
- FFP2 masks to be wear
- One-way routes for athletes from the finish area to the cable car
- RED and BLUE Group must not use the same cabins and should never mix

START

- The start area is reserved for athletes, team members and start personnel (all with RED accreditation). It is fenced in and cannot be entered by staff (except with RED accreditation) and guests.
- Start gate: max, 4 athletes + 1 team member with FFP2 mask
- 1 Start Judge, 1 Swiss Timing Starter, 1 Hand Timing, 1 Access Controller (all with FFP2 mask)
- The colored bib numbers will be handed out by 2 persons (with RED accreditation) and only in the open
- Observe mask obligation and distancing

COURSE CREW

- Entering the course area only with a valid Green Pass
- They wear a colored vest to distinguish them and must avoid any contact with another group.
- Obligation to wear a mask and keep a distance

AWARD CEREMONY AT FINISH AREA

- The official flower Ceremony and price giving ceremony will be held immediately after the race on Sunday and Monday.
- Athletes enter from the fenced areas
- Employees involved with the award ceremony have their own entrance
- The flowers and prices are set on the podium in order to avoid contact for the athletes
- Masks must be worn during the entire stay
- Avoid shaking hands
- Keep the minimum distance
- Follow the signs and stay in your assigned zones
- Observe the general safety and hygiene measures





MEDIA

ON-SITE

- The Media Center is located an the RACE OFFICE FINISH AREA
- To access the Media Center everyone must have a valid Green Pass that will be controlled at the entrance
- Mouth and nose protection (FFP2)
- During the event, all interviews must be conducted in the Mixed Zone in the finish area

ACCREDITATION & MEDIA CENTER

- All journalists have a valid Green Pass to pick up their accreditation
- All journalist must send the accreditation form (www.ski-cross.it) to gabriel@innichen.it
- · Accreditations are handed out in the RACE OFFICE at the finish area
- FIS Passport is not necessary for journalists
- Obligation to wear masks
- Keep a minimum distance of 1,5 min
- It is the responsibility of every person to adhere to this policy

PRESS CONFERENCES

• According to the OC, this year will not be official press conferences after the races

TV-CABINS

- Host broadcaster, Timing & Data (group BLUE) must have a valid Green Pass
- Max. 2 persons per cabin
- Disinfectants are available in each cabin
- Obligation to wear masks
- The cabins are cleaned and disinfected daily

PHOTO ZONES

- A mouth and nose protection must be worn the whole time
- Observe the distancing rules
- Photographers are not allowed to enter the finish area to take pictures of the award ceremony. For this reason, the podium will be rotated so that pictures can be taken directly from the photographers' stand in the finish area.
