Les Contamines and the French Ski Federation are pleased to invite all freestyle nations to attend to the FIS Ski Cross Europa Cup and FIS race in Les Contamines on March 22nd to 26th 2022.

2. RULES

- The French Freestyle Association and the Ski Club Les Contamines Committee organise an international Ski Cross Europa Cup competition, part of the 2021/2022 FIS Freestyle Europa Cup Circuit.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.
- This competition is a Ski Cross event and is open to both men and women
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, or by the decision of the competition jury.

3. ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS qualification quotas and rules for the Freestyle Europa Cup.

FIS Points Requirement to participate in European Cup Competitions:

- Minimum 35 Ski Cross FIS points or max 150 Alpine Points in any Ski Alpine Event. Please complete the Team Entry Form (found on the FIS Website) and send it to Ms Gaëlle Blanchard Revilliod from the Organising Committee by email:

4. REGISTRATION AND MEANS OF PAYMENT

The team payment will take place on Monday, 21 st, 2022 from 4.00 pm to 7.00 pm and on Tuesday, 22nd, from 5.00 am to 7.00 pm at the Club des Sports.

All fees and deposits must be paid in EUROS in cash or bank transfer (for fees) -

No cheques and no travellers' cheques will be accepted.

Entry & ticket fee:

- 150 CHF or EURO per athlete per Europa Cup (for 2 races)
- 90 CHF or EURO per athlete per FIS Race (for 1 race)
- 30 CHF or EURO per athlete for the unofficial training day

According to the FIS rules:

- 1 > 3 competitors : 3 coach free
- 4 > 8 competitors : 5 coaches free
- 9 & more: 6 coaches free
- 27 € per day for all other coaches

5. ACCOMMODATION & WAX ROOM

Teams are free to book accommodation of their choice.

In case of you will need a storage & wax room for your material during this period, please feel free to arrange it directly with your hotel/residence this year.

6. TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING

7. BIBS AND HELMETS

It is mandatory for all competitors to wear bibs and helmets during official training, competitions and award ceremony (bib only). A penalty will be charged to every competitor who does not wear his/her bib. Each Team leader will have to pay a 10€ deposit per bib. The deposit will be refund at the end of the competition when bibs are returned.

8. LIABILITY

All competitors, officials and other members of their National Association who attend or participate in the event shall do so at their own risk.

The Organising Committee, Ski Club Les Contamines, the French Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries occurred or suffered by competitors, officials or any other persons in conjunction with the organisation or staging of the event.

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.

9. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Every competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee: Les Contamines Ski Resort, the FIS and the French Ski Association will not be held responsible for accidents and, damaged equipment during the training and competitions.

10. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the Les Contamines Medical Centre or local hospital.
