Dear Freestyle Ski Friends,

The Russian Ski Association and the Freestyle Federation of Russia are happy to invite all national teams to take part in the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups to be held on March 05th - March 06th 2022, in Kuzbass.

The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition Rules (ICR) of the International Ski Federation (FIS).

ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following the FIS quotas and rules.

Please submit your team's provisional entries for all team members (officials, service, coaches and athletes with names) by January 24th, 2022

The final number of your team members (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the Organizing Committee **no later than February 23rd, 2022**

FIS has established national Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas are available under the following link:

ACCREDITATION

Personal data and passport type photos for every participant will be required for event accreditation. All badges will be handed over to team representatives upon arrival and are necessary for entering the venue and the team hotels. VISA SUPPORT

The Organizing Committee provides support and assistance to all teams at each step of the Russian visa application process.

In order to receive a visa invitation, please provide the following information:

- a scanned copy of passport in good quality;
- Russian Consulate of which city you are planning on applying for visa at, incl. estimated date of visit;
- information about place of employment, including:

Address;

Position;

Phone/Fax.

In order to make sure that all teams get their visas in due time before the event, all National Ski Associations are kindly asked to send their visa invitation requests as early as possible for all participants that may qualify for the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cups in the Kuzbass.

ACCOMMODATION, MEALS AND TRANSFERS

As per the FIS Rule, accommodation and meals will be charged by the Organizing Committee in RUR equivalent of CHF 50 per day per person.





Half board will be provided to the teams beginning with dinner on March 1st and ending with breakfast on March 07th. Upgrade to FB is offered at CHF 10 per person per day.

One single room per team will be provided. An odd number resulting in a 2nd single room will be charged at the equivalent of CHF 100. Additional single room requests are subject to availability at market rates.

Accommodation will be provided to all teams from 00.00 on March 1st, 2022 till 12.00 on March 07th, 2022.

Same conditions cannot be guaranteed outside of these dates (earlier arrivals or later departures).

The official place of accommodation: Ski Resort "Gornaya Salanga", <u>https://www.salanga.ru//</u>

The OC offers transfers between the airport of Kemerovo and the resort (busses for teams and trucks for equipment). Cost for two ways at a total of CHF 100 per person, regardless of the size of the team and amount of luggage.

Local transportation will not be needed as you will be accommodated on the ski resort not far from bottom station of the ski lift.

Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

All payments on site are to be made in local currency (Russian rubles) in cash or by bank card (VISA/MasterCard) upon arrival at the Welcome zone. Currency exchange services will be available at the airport of arrival (Kemerovo). ATM is not available on site.

LIFT

Free Entry to the lifts will be available during Official trainings and Competitions days. Outside of this dates cost of daily Ski-Pass will be charged at the equivalent of CHF 20.

RACE OFFICE

Race Office, Welcome zone and the information desk will be located at the Venue of the event.

Team registration and team captains meetings will be held at the Venue according to the event schedule.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Each competitor must carry his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, FIS, Russian Ski Association and Freestyle





Federation of Russia assume no responsibility for accidents, damage or loss of equipment, nor second or third party claims during the event.

In the case of accidents on course during competition or trainings, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee will be responsible for any medical decision in cooperation with the respective team's medical personnel and local hospital.

COVID-19

The Organizing Committee will follow the respective guidelines of FIS and the Russian Government.

All participants must have their own medical insurance which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment costs.

Every person taking part in the event must submit a negative COVID-19 PCR Test, which was made not earlier than 72 hours prior to their arrival to the event. During Event all participants must be testing each 3 days.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.

PRIZE MONEY

All prize money will be issued following the new FIS prize money process. NSAs must manage all information required for prize money using the FIS Athlete Registration module in the FIS member section. All bank information MUST be uploaded to the FIS database prior to Finals. Athletes without the correct bank information uploaded to the FIS system will experience a delay in prize money bank transfer.

The winners will receive prize money via bank transfer only (no checks).

25,000 CHF will be awarded per gender, for each event. Prize money will be awarded to the top 10 men and top 10 women.
