COVID-19 Prevention measures and recommendations for teams as part of the Audi FIS Ski World Cup 2021/22 in Arosa, Switzerland

Last update: December 3, 2021

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the **Audi FIS Ski World Cup in Arosa from 14th to 15th December 2021** must be held under increased security measures. According to the current regulations of the Switzerland Federal Ministry of Health (BAG) and the additional measures from the "Verein Internationale Schneesport Events Arosa" as the organizer in addition the regulations from the FIS, we hereby send the protocol of the current measurements to be taken by the teams as from 03.12.2021.

By registering for this event, each team member confirms and accepts the content of this protocol of measurements for the above-mentioned event to the fullest.

Important safety measures

- Taking personal responsibility
- Hygiene measures (regular hand washing, regular disinfection)
- Maintain a minimum distance of 1.5 meter in all areas (social distancing)
- Wearing mouth and nose protector (surgical face mask)
 - on the entire event site, except
 - during mealtimes
 - during the practice of sport
 - athletes in the start and warm-up area
 - in all closed rooms
 - for all transports in buses, shuttles and in common areas of your accommodation
 - in all enclosed areas of the cable cars. This applies both in the gondola and in the waiting rooms and toilets.

Check your own health situation daily (if you feel ill and suffer from symptoms such as fever, flu symptoms or other symptoms like described in the following chart, stay in your room and call the SOS COVID-19 HOTLINE +41 79 377 23 14.

Due to the Covid-19 situation, the organization committee is obliged to limit the number of accredited people. Therefore, only team officials, according to the current FIS quota, will be granted access to the team and sports relevant areas. People outside the current FIS-quotas will not be granted access to the above-mentioned areas and will not be able to stay in the exclusively designated team accommodation.

Daily Health Questionnaire (optional)

Do you have fever of 38.0 degree Celsius or higher?
Are you coughing more than usual, especially dry cough?
Do you have shortness of breath?
Do you have loss of taste and/or smell, stuffy nose, unusual aches, abnormal fatigue, unusual headache, or nausea/vomiting and diarrhea?
Have you tested positive to the PCR-test during the last 14 days?

Journey to Arosa

- In case of COVID-19 symptoms do not travel to the venue!
- Avoid stops between the departure point and the event location
- Avoid contact with other people - especially outside the team
- If persons close to you or people in your environment are ill with COVID-19, please call the SOS COVID-19 Hotline +41 79 377 23 14

Accreditation

Due to the current situation, we as organizers must limit the number of accredited persons, please only accredit people who are really working during the World Cup races.

In addition to the accreditation, each person will receive an identification bractlet with different colors (Red for the red group, Orange for the group Rest).

*Furthermore, in addition to the PCR test uploaded on the FIS Passport, the FIS COVID-19 World Cup Risk Management and Testing Protocol Rules requires all non-vaccinated or non previously infected persons to undergo one more rapid test every 24h. If you need the rapid test, please contact Annina Felix (annina.felix@arosa.swiss) beforehand.

Please note that a certificate can only be issued for the following vaccines:

- Comirnaty® / BNT162b2 / Tozinameran (Pfizer/BioNTech)
- Spikevax® / mRNA-1273 / COVID-19 vaccine (Moderna)
- Vaxzevria® / AZD1222 / Covishield™ or other licensed products (AstraZeneca)
- COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen (Johnson & Johnson)

Hotel

- The LOC has reserved team accommodation.
- The hotels are currently reserved only for athletes and officials according to the FIS quota for the period of the official arrival 12.12.2021 until the official departure on 16.12.2021
- Should team members arrive early or leave later, please inform the LOC immediately at the following e-mail address: annina.felix@arosa.swiss (capacity is limited)
- Check-in of all team members by the team captain. Each team member is obliged to stay in the accommodation allocated by the LOC for the duration of the event.
- Catering in the hotel is only possible with a valid Covid-Certificate.
- Wearing a mouth and nose protector in all public areas is mandatory.
- In the buffet area a mouth and nose protector are mandatory and can be taken off at the table.
- Maintain social distancing in all areas.
- Further hygiene measures according to the hotels policy. These precautions make sure that the bubble system works out neatly.

Drive from the accommodation to the event site

- Preferred transport in the own team vehicles.
- Avoid stops between the hotel and the venue.

Event site

- Maintain social distancing
- Remain in the assigned and marked team zones (red zone).
- The team zone (red zone) is fenced off and only accessible to designated accredited people.
- Avoid direct contact with other teams, employees, staff, or press.
- Mouth and nose protection must be worn on the event site. Exceptions:
 - During the practice of sport
 - Mealtimes
 - At the start and warm-up area, athletes do not need mouth-and-nose protection, but mouth-and-nose protection is mandatory for all coaches/service staff/officials.
- This number is serviced 24 hours a day from the official arrival until the official departure.
- In case of symptoms, an isolation room is reserved near the event site.

Mixed Zone & Media

- TV/radio/press must maintain social distance from athletes.
- TV/radio/press must wear masks (during interviews).
- The number of media representatives will be severely restricted in agreement with the FIS.

Team Captains Meeting (TCM)

- The TCM takes place physically at the Sport- and Conference Centre, 1 person per team is allowed.

Doping Control

- If a doping control will take place, athletes, doctors, team doctors and chaperones must wear a mouth and nose protector throughout the entire doping control.
- Wash and disinfect hands before and after the doping control.

COVID-19 Communication

- If any member of the team feels unwell or has COVID-19 symptoms, contact the LOC immediately at the Single Point of Contact +41 79 377 23 14 activates the rescue chain.
- All communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with the FIS and the LOC.

Covid-19 Testing in Arosa during your stay

- PCR and rapid tests are available in Arosa (PCR CHF 180.00/person, Rapid Test CHF 60.00/person) has to be paid directly in the testcentre.
- There is a test slot reserved on 14th December (between 8.00 and 12.00 am) where all athletes can do a PCR-Test to get the result in time traveling to the next destination. The LOC will define a timetable.
- Testing facilities are situated right in front of the Sports- and Conference Centre Arosa.

To minimize the risk of infection, the LOC recommends the following safety measurements:

- Remain in small groups.
- Avoid contact with other teams.
- Avoid contact with LOC staff.
- Avoid contact with tourists/fans.
- Interviews with journalists only with socially accepted distance and mouth and nose protection.
- Wash and disinfect your hands regularly.
- Documentation of your current health status.

We appeal to EVERYONE to take their OWN RESPONSIBILITY and comply and implement all measurements and recommendations made! Guidelines are used to implement or control compliance with the COVID-19 specifications. For your own safety and the safety of other people, you must follow the instructions of the operational staff.

We reserve the right to exclude you from the event and to take legal action in the event of non-compliance with the COVID-19 regulations.

The measurements defined were determined in accordance with the current regulations in Switzerland by the government from 03.12.2021. The organizer reserves the right to make necessary changes, which will be announced immediately.
