### **COVID-19 Situation**

In order to ensure the health and safety for the athletes and team personnel, the LOC is working in accordance with the Regional and National Health regulations as well as with FIS in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines together with the World Health Organisation (WHO) information and recommendations. The LOC and FIS Event Task Force has been established and is monitoring all developments. The corresponding arrangements are currently being put together in a separate document. This will be published and communicated by the LOC at a later stage. All competitors must have their own medical insurance (ICR art 212) which shall cover COVID-19 medical treatment expenses. Updated COVID-19 relevant medical procedures that may be required will be communicated whenever relevant.

## **Registration/Entries**

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

All updated entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page: <a href="http://www.fis-ski.com/">http://www.fis-ski.com/</a> "Member Section". FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations.

#### **Deadlines for Team Entries:**

Preliminary Entries (women/men): November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021

Final Entries: December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021

### Accommodation

According to the FIS Rules the rates are CHF 60.00/night per team member (athletes and team officials) for accommodation, including half-board and has to be paid directly at the hotel. Accommodation at the FIS rate will be provided for the period of December 12 – 16, 2021; 4 nights. Two single rooms per country for the team officials will be provided. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves directly at the hotel.

"No Shows" will be charged to the National Associations directly at the Hotel.

Important information: To accommodate all athletes, coaches and officials in a correct way, we do need your updated Preliminary Team Entries as soon as possible, November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the latest.

After the above mentioned Deadline for Team Entries the FIS rate for hotel accommodation can't be guaranteed anymore.
