- As these are the season Finals for the Snowboard Cross World Cup and the Audi FIS Ski Cross World Cup there are only the top 16 women and top 32 men allowed to participate.
- Eligible are all competitors mentioned by the National Association with a signed FIS athlete declaration.
- All athletes, officials and other representatives of National Associations participate at their own risk. The organisers are not liable for any damage or injuries caused or sustained by athletes, officials or any other persons in connection with the event.

The teams will partly be housed in apartments. For this reason it is imperatively for each team to respect the registration deadlines. In case of non-respect of the deadlines, the OC won't guarantee the wished accommodation.

#### **COVID-19 Situation**
