AASA Current Standard Policy

Covid19 Protocols for Alberta Alpine sanctioned races.

For all **U14**, **U16**, **FIS** and **Masters** Alberta Alpine sanctioned races, all participants (coaches, officials, athletes, volunteers, and spectators inside the fence) must be fully vaccinated or show proof in written or printed copy that indicates the individual has tested, within 72 hours of the event, a negative test for Covid19 (at the participants cost) on a Health Canada approved Rapid Antigen, Rapid PCR or lab-based PCR test approved by Health Canada or the lab accreditation body of jurisdiction to attend the event. **(FOR CLARIFICATION: NEGATIVE TEST MUST BE LAB PERFORMED, NOT A SELF CONDUCTED RAT)**

Ski Resorts may have enhanced Covid19 protocols, these protocols may exceed AASA protocols, but the Ski Resort Protocols must be followed.

Participants must have received at least 2 doses of a Government of Canada accepted Covid19 vaccine or mix of 2 accepted vaccines or at least 1 dose of the Janssen/Johnson & Johnson's vaccine. The second dose of vaccine must have been given 14 full days prior to the event/race.

Each ROC will manage this program and AASA strongly suggests that each ROC has a Covid19 Officer assigned to the race. There is no need to hold any personal information of any of the participants. The Alberta Government Covid19 scan app will verify if the participant is fully vaccinated.

Ski Team Clubhouse/Race Office:	For Volunteers and Coaches, the Clubhouse/Race Office is participating the REP program therefore we will be checking everyone (all volunteers, coaches and even athletes) who enter for Proof of Vaccination (POV). Masks are required at ALL TIMES in the Clubhouse/Race Office. (NEGATIVE TEST IS NOT ACCEPTED FOR CLUBHOUSE/RACE OFFICE ADDMISSION)
Public Daylodge:	Public daylodge is available to the public and Participants. It is operating under the REP and Proof of Vaccination and masking is required. (Negative Test is accepted for Public Daylodge access but must be a private lab test, NOT AHS Supplied nor self conducted RAT)
Washroom Access:	Daylodge Washrooms are accessible from the exterior of the Daylodge building and POV is not required.

Definitions:

"Racer" means each fully vaccinated against Covid-19 participating racer registered to complete in the Sunridge Western SX on January 7th, 8th and 9th 2022 and listed on Schedule "A".

"Coach" means each fully vaccinated against Covid-19 participating coach attending the Sunridge Western SX on January 7th, 8th and 9th 2022 and listed on Schedule "B".

"Valid Record" means scanning a QR Code Covid-19 Immunization Record and verifying the name and date of birth using the COVID-19 Vaccination AB Covid Records Verifier.

- I have confirmed a Valid Record that each racer/coach has received the full series of a COVID-19 Vaccine authorized by Health Canada or any combination of such vaccines and received the final dose at least 14 days prior to the commencement of this event.
- I agree to confirm with each racer/coach a daily symptom self-screening check and will let organizers know if any racer have experienced any symptoms in the last 14 days.
- I confirm no racer/coach has been instructed to self-isolate or quarantine during the last 14 days, nor have they tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 10 days or are awaiting COVID-19 test results due to symptoms.
- I agree each racer/coach may be asked to provide evidence of their vaccination status should it be requested to be presented.
- I confirm each racer/coach will abide by all the COVID-19 Polices and Guidelines provided by Sunridge Ski Area and Alberta Alpine.
- I confirm each racer/coach will abide by all the COVID-19 Policies and Guidelines provided by Race Organizing Committee either in the race notice or through official event communications during the event.
- I confirm each racer/coach understands that if they do not abide by the aforementioned policies/guidelines, they may be asked to leave the site.

I acknowledge, on behalf of each racer/coach, that there are risks associated with participating in sport activities, and that the measures taken by the Race Organizing Committee, clubs, teams and participants, including those set out above and under the COVID-19 Response Plan and Return to Sport Protocols, will not entirely eliminate those risks.

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"Coach" means each un-vaccinated against Covid-19 participating coach attending the Sunridge Western SX on January 7th, 8th and 9th, 2022 and listed on Schedule "B".

A negative test result must be completed for Covid-19 in writing by a Health Canada approved Rapid Antigen or lab-Based PCR test.
