COVID	MANDATORY VACCINATION FOR PARTICIPATION		
PROTOCOLS & INFORMATION:	<ul> <li>This event requires all participants including athletes, coaches, service and team personnel, volunteers, and officials to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 as per the Canadian standards for vaccination. These standards are having received the full series of an accepted Canadian COVID-19 vaccine or a full series of a combination of accepted vaccines. You MUST have received your last dose at least 14 full days prior to the commencement of the event.</li> <li>IMPORTANT: All participants MUST fill out the COVID waiver in advance of their participation of the event: <a href="https://alpinepoints.ca/eventWaiver/4123/">https://alpinepoints.ca/eventWaiver/4123/</a></li> <li>Failure to execute the waiver or falsely complete the waiver will leave the individual ineligible to participate in the competition. Anyone under the age of 18 MUST have their legal guardian execute the waiver.</li> <li>It is an individual's requirement to be aware of and adhere to all COVID-19 rules and regulations for accommodations at the resort venue. Masks must be worn in all indoor spaces. Face covering must be worn while riding the chairlift, and in all fields of play at all times, except by the athletes on their competition run. Wash hands frequently. Maintain social distancing. Resort COVID-19 protocol is subject to change in accordance with the Provincial Health recommendations.</li> <li>The COVID-19 officer will be identified at the first Team Captains' meeting and available for connection for the duration of the event.</li> </ul>		
ELIGIBILITY: ENTRY DEADLINE:	According to FIS eligibility rules, athlete MUST have a FIS Freestyle License.  January 24, 2022 for all entries. Official FIS entry forms. Withdrawals must be submitted with confirmation to ACA 5 days prior to the first Team Captains' meeting. Failure to comply will result in monetary sanction.

TO CANADA:	A Pre-entry PCR test is required for all travelers.		
	Please view the link below for all requirements to enter Canada both via aircraft or car. It is the responsibility of the traveler to be aware of the requirements to enter Canada.		
	In addition, all individuals entering Canada MUST use the ArriveCAN app to enter proof of vaccination, quarantine, and travel information up to 72 hours before your travel. Failure to provide the information in ArriveCAN before arriving at the border, will means you WILL NOT be considered as a fully vaccinated traveler even if you meet all the other requirements.
